### A New Initiative: Connect Groups

As a parish, we have run Alpha Courses for nearly five years now, and those who have attended Alpha often wonder, "What's next?" We finally have a good answer to that question! Those of you who are "Alpha Alumni" or have been part of an Encounter Retreat like Cursillo or the Life in the Spirit Seminar, are invited to consider becoming part of a "Connect Group" beginning in February. These mid-sized groups offer an opportunity to again experience some of the best elements of Alpha; eating together, prayer, open sharing, and friendship. Connect Groups will meet in a host family's home every two weeks and are made up of 20-30 people. Each meeting follows a similar schedule, usually from 6:00 to 8:30 p.m.:

- \* Arrival
- \* Blessing and a potluck meal
- \* Icebreaker/Intro
- \* Short testimony or talk
- \* Small group break-out (3-4 people) to discuss talk
- \* Prayer, songs and intercession
- \* Wrap-up


