

## A MESSAGE FROM FR. STEVE

### Fun Fundraiser for the Shamrock Club

Saturday night (3/17) after the 5:00 p.m. Mass, you are all invited to take part in the third annual Bean Bag Toss Tournament, a fundraiser put on by our Resurrection Shamrock Club, which supports the athletic program here. It's a great evening of food, fellowship, and fun. ### **Mass for Families of Miscarriage and Child Loss**

Bishop Boyea will celebrate a Mass for families and friends who have experienced the tragedy of miscarriage or the loss of a child. It will be held at our church this Sunday (March 18) at 1:00 p.m. There will be a simple punch reception with Bishop Boyea to immediately follow the Mass in Mercy Hall.

### **Family Healing Mass**

Next Saturday morning, March 24, from 10-12:30, you are invited to join us for an audio talk by Dr. Bob Schuchts about the power of the sacraments for healing. There will be time after the talk for everyone to reflect on the generational effects of sin in their own families, and then to celebrate a Mass for the healing of families. (Please note that this will not be a Mass for the Anointing of the Sick.) ### **"When I Am Lifted Up . . .**

. . . I will draw everyone to myself." That's what Jesus says this week in the Gospel (John 12:32). In last week's Gospel, Jesus said that He (the Son of Man) will be lifted up, as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert. The implication is that He will be the source of our healing, even as the serpent on the pole was the means of healing for those who had been bitten by serpents. The beautiful truth is that Jesus willingly chose to become the remedy for our brokenness, wounds, sinfulness, and shame. Jesus is the answer to our feeling abandoned, rejected, fearful, ashamed, powerless, hopeless, and/or confused. All of those wounds (and the sins that follow from them) are a result of our having been bitten by the lies of the evil one, who is the devil who took the form of a serpent in the Garden of Eden.

Jesus is the answer to the fundamental wound of our human condition, and offers the Truth that sets us free. (You can find a handout with prayers that renounce lies and announce truth at the exits of the church.)

### **"Only Say the Word . . .**

and my soul shall be healed." Today, when I lift Jesus up in the Blessed Sacrament, we will all pray the powerful prayer, "Lord, I am not worthy to receive you under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed," which was inspired by the centurion's words in Matthew 8:

*When Jesus entered Capernaum, a centurion approached him and appealed to him, saying, "Lord, my servant is lying at home paralyzed, suffering dreadfully." He said to him, "I will come and cure him." The centurion said in reply, "Lord, I am not worthy to have you enter under my roof; only say the word and my servant will be healed. For I too am a man subject to authority, with soldiers subject to me. And I say to one, 'Go,' and he goes; and to another, 'Come here,' and he comes; and to my slave, 'Do this,' and he does it."*

*When Jesus heard this, he was amazed and said to those following him, "Amen, I say to you, in no one in Israel have I found such faith . . . And Jesus said to the centurion, "You may go; as you have believed, let it be done for you." And at that very hour [his] servant was healed. (Matthew 8:5-10, 13). Let us all be among those who believe that Jesus truly is the remedy for us and for all those we love. And may He "say the word" that we may be healed.*

### **Prayers for Healing**

A reminder that each weekend, after the morning Masses on Sundays, you can stop by Mercy Hall Conference Room for prayer ministry. Because of the special Mass at 1:00 p.m. this weekend, there will be *no Café*, but we will have coffee & donuts, as usual. Even though there will be no Café, Sean and Liz O'Neill will be available for brief (10-15 minute) prayer sessions after both morning Masses. They are also able to meet with people for longer prayer times on Saturday and Sunday afternoons in the parish office. Many molds from the 1600-1900s have been reproduced, and we will be using historic carved European Easter mold replicas to make cookies together.




