

## A MESSAGE FROM FR. STEVE

### Ascension of the Lord

Jesus is Risen from the dead! For forty days, he appeared to the believers and encouraged them in their belief. He desires to encourage us in our belief as well. Today, in the Acts of the Apostles, we read, *While meeting with them, he enjoined them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for "the promise of the Father about which you have heard me speak; for John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."* And, ". . . you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Celebrating the Ascension, we now wait, with the entire Church, to "receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon [us]."

### Celebrating, Seniors!

### Lumen Veritatis

Our final *Lumen Veritatis* lecture of this season will be held next Saturday May 19<sup>th</sup>, when Joseph Pearce, author of many biographies of literary giants including Shakespeare, J.R.R.R. Tolkien, C.S. Lewis, G. K. Chesterton, Oscar Wilde, Alexander Solzhenitsyn, and Hilaire Belloc will be here. He will speak on the topic, "A Matter of Life and Death: The Battle for a True Education." In an age of radical relativism and secular fundamentalism, the very future of education is under threat. Pearce will unmask the poison of modern education and its anti-Christian agenda. He also reveals the marks of the true education, which counters the culture of death with eternal life-giving verities. Please save the dates, and plan to join us for our final lecture of the season. The evening begins with drinks and simple appetizers at 7:00 p.m. at Lansing Catholic High School. The talk will begin at 7:30, followed by questions & answers and then fellowship. We typically wrap up the evening around 9:00 p.m. It's a great opportunity for adults in the parish and community to come together to grow in our knowledge of our faith, and to spend time focusing on the Good, the True, and the Beautiful.

### Blessed John Henry Newman

Last week in my homily, I quoted from some reflections of Blessed John Henry Newman, which highlighted the importance that each and every one of us has in the family of God. Here are some of his "Meditations on Christian Doctrine" from what is annotated to be reflections for March 7 (a link to the entire webpage can be found on our website):

*God was all-complete, all-blessed in Himself; but it was His will to create a world for His glory. He is Almighty, and might have done all things Himself, but it has been His will to bring about His purposes by the beings He has created. We are all {301} created to His glory—we are created to do His will. I am created to do something or to be something for which no one else is created; I have a place in God's counsels, in God's world, which no one else has; whether I be rich or poor, despised or esteemed by man, God knows me and calls me by my name.*

*God has created me to do Him some definite service; He has committed some work to me which He has not committed to another.*

*I have my mission . . . Somehow I am necessary for His purposes, as necessary in my place as an Archangel in his . . . I have a part in this great work; I am a link in a chain, a bond of connexion between persons. He has not created me for naught. I shall do good, I shall do His work; I shall be an angel of peace, a preacher of truth in my own place . . . if I do but keep His commandments and serve Him in my calling.*

### Diocesan Services Appeal 2018


