



### Diocesan Services Appeal 2018

At this point, fifty-nine of us have made a pledge to DSA. The total pledged thus far is \$18,796, which is 26% of our parish goal of \$72,386. Thank you to those who have made your pledge! I know that Bishop Boyea is concerned about DSA this year, and I'm hopeful that we will be able to show our support for him. One sign of that would be to have a high percentage of families make a pledge, even if it is a smaller amount than we would normally give to DSA. I want to readily acknowledge that some of us have pledged significant amounts to the Witness to Hope, which may make it difficult to give what we typically pledge. However, especially if you didn't make a pledge to Witness to Hope, would you please consider pledging even more than you typically would, since last year's DSA was folded in to the Witness to Hope campaign? Given that we are hoping to be able to move forward with our sanctuary, I would like to show bishop the support we have for him and the ongoing work of the diocese. Let's all pray that we will be able to make our DSA goal, if at all possible. Thank you! 
