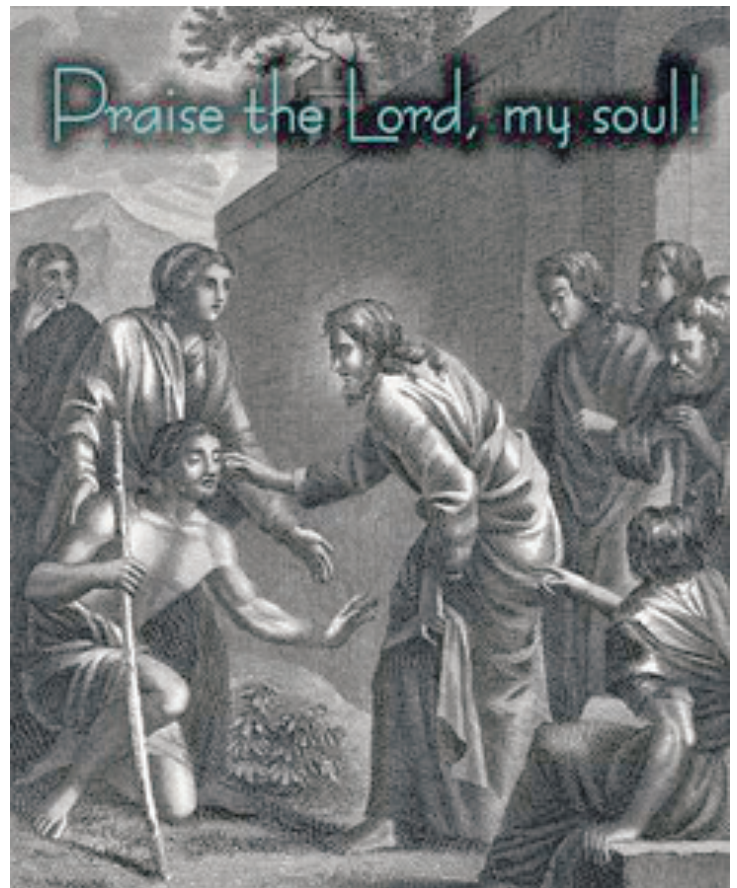

her insight.

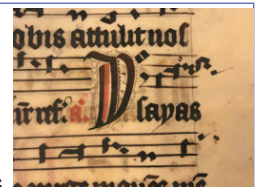
Don't know how to read music? No problem. *I'm serious.*

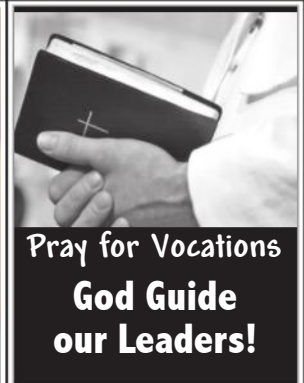
