### Why We're Here . . .

After that, on the Eighth Day (the Octave) of Christmas, which is January 1, we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of God. We will have a Vigil Mass at 4:30 p.m. December 31 as well Mass during the night at 10:30 p.m., followed by adoration and Benediction just prior to Midnight. New Year's Day we will have one Mass at 10:00 a.m.

If those times won't work for you, please check with surrounding parishes to begin the new year well, by praising our Lord. Please note that our offices will be closed on December 24-26 and again on December 31<sup>st</sup> and January 1<sup>st</sup>. ### Merry Christmas!






