A MESSAGE FROM FR. STEVE

Congratulations, First Communicants!

Yesterday (Saturday, May 5), the entire Church of God rejoiced with the families of those who received Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament for the first time. It is always a joyful occasion, one filled with great anticipation by children, their families, and (most of all) the Lord. He desires to give Himself to us in the Eucharist, and He has a special place in His heart for children. May we all always be like those children who look forward eagerly to receive Jesus. Again, let me express my sincere thanks to Sr. Veronica Marie, who teaches 2nd Grade teacher in the school, and Angie Amburn, who has worked with our religious education and home-school students as they have prepared for First Reconciliation and First Communion.

Super Raffle

You may have noticed in the bulletin last weekend that we are having a "Super Raffle" to support the work of the parish and school. Update on Renovation

As many of you know, the original draft for the renovation was very different from the one that we developed with the help of Tom Rajkovich. We have received approval of the design by the diocesan liturgy design committee and Bishop Boyea. At this point, we have asked Tom Rajkovich to develop biddable drawings that will allow us to get a better estimate of the true cost of these renovations. After that, we will have more information to share with the parish, and, if the funds are available, we will then need to get final approval from the diocesan finance council to proceed with the renovations. Please pray for the remaining steps in the process, and thanks for your ongoing support of the Witness to Hope campaign.

An Introduction to Ignatian Rules of Discernment (May 9, May 16 and May 23)

Earlier this year, I gave a three-talk series on Mental Prayer. After completing that, and prayer and consultation, we decided to invite in a team who is involved with training spiritual directors at Christ the King Catholic Church in Ann Arbor. Jeannette Barbacane and Tesa Fleming will discuss the basic movements of consolation and desolation as developed by St. Ignatius of Loyola, and will provide practical guidance and "homework" to continue the practice of mental prayer which was addressed in Fr. Steve's earlier series on Mental/Contemplative Prayer. Tesa and Jeannette are experienced and gifted spiritual directors and come with a wealth of knowledge and advice on how to discern God's will for your life, how to enter more deeply into a relationship with God, and how to progress along the spiritual path

that the saints followed towards ultimate union with Christ, culminating in the beatific vision of heaven. I am grateful that they have agreed to teach this second part of the prayer course. The talks will be held Thursday May 9, 16, and 23 in Mercy Hall, beginning at 7:00 p.m. Hope to see you there!

Men's Evening of Adoration (Friday)

Because of the Prayer Series, we will move our Men's Evening of Adoration from Thursday to Friday this week. It will be from 7-8 p.m., with fellowship following.

Charismatic Mass (monthly on the Second Sunday at 1:30)


Over the past few years, several members of the parish approached me to see about the possibility of us offering a "Charismatic Mass" at our parish. We will do so once a month at 1:30 p.m. on the Second Sundays of the month, beginning next Sunday, May 12th. You might wonder what it would be like. Basically, everything in the Mass will be the same as our 9:00 a.m. Mass, with two exceptions. First, we will take time for extended adoration and praise at the conclusion of the Gloria, during which those who are present are free to lift their hearts and their hands in prayer, and also, if they feel so moved, to pray "in the spirit" using prayer tongues. Second, there will also be an extended time of thanks, praise, and worship after communion.

Today (Sunday, May 5th) at St. Mary Cathedral, Bishop Boyea will be confirming students from Resurrection along with those from other Diocese of Lansing parishes. Please pray for the candidates as well as their families and sponsors as they prepare their hearts to receive the abundant graces of Confirmation. 




