A MESSAGE FROM FR. STEVE

Ascension of the Lord

Jesus is Risen from the dead! For forty days, he appeared to the believers and encouraged them in their belief. He desires to encourage us in our belief as well. Today, in the Acts of the Apostles, we read, *While meeting with them, he enjoined them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for "the promise of the Father about which you have heard me speak; for John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit." And, "... you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."* Celebrating the Ascension, we now wait, with the entire Church, to "receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon [us]."

Summer Schedule

Beginning next week and running through August 26th, which is the first Monday school Mass, there will be no Monday morning confessions or Masses. Nearby, there are several good options for Monday Masses: St. Therese has an 8:30 a.m. Mass, the cathedral has a 12:05 p.m. Mass, and St. John's has a Mass at 12:15 p.m. on Mondays. There are other local Masses as well, which you can find by searching the Mass Times website (masstimes.org). Note also that, for the summer, parish office hours on Fridays will be 9:00 – 12:00 noon. (August 30th, we will return to the normal Friday hours: 9:00-12:00; 1-4:30 p.m.)

Charismatic Mass (monthly on the Second Sunday at 1:30)

Our next "Charismatic Mass" will be next Sunday, June 9th at 1:30 p.m. You might wonder what it would be like. Basically, everything in the Mass will be the same as our 9:00 a.m. Mass, with two exceptions. First, we will take time for extended adoration and praise at the conclusion of the Gloria, during which those who are present are free to lift their hearts and their hands in prayer, and also, if they feel so moved, to pray "in the spirit" using prayer tongues. Second, there will also be an extended time of thanks, praise, and worship after communion.

Prayer Vigil for Vocations to the Priesthood

Next Saturday, June 8th, would ordinarily be the day when Bishop Boyea would ordain priests for service in the Diocese of Lansing. However, this year we have no men who will be ordained. The bishop has asked all parishes to pray for vocations, and we will have an all night prayer vigil from 8:00 p.m. Friday the 7th through 7:30 a.m., when we will have Benediction. You can sign up for an hour to pray for vocations on our website.

St. John Vianney (Patron Saint of Diocesan Priests), Pray for Us

In his *Catechism on the Priesthood*, St. John Vianney writes the following:

Saint Bernard tells us that everything has come to us through Mary; and we may also say that everything has come to us through the priest; yes, all happiness, all graces, all heavenly gifts. If we had not the Sacrament of Orders, we should not have Our Lord. Who placed Him there, in that tabernacle? It was the priest. Who was it that received your soul, on its entrance into life? The priest. Who nourishes it, to give it strength to make its pilgrimage? The priest. Who will prepare it to appear before God, by washing that soul, for the last time, in the blood of Jesus Christ? The priest -- always the priest. And if that soul comes to the point of death, who will raise it up, who will restore it to calmness and peace? Again the priest. You cannot recall one single blessing from God without finding, side by side with this recollection, the image of the priest.

These beautiful words from St. John Vianney remind me of the great dignity of the priesthood, and humble me that the Lord has called me to this great honor and service to you. May we be a parish that fosters vocations to the priesthood and religious life. Come, Holy Spirit!

PRINCIPAL'S CORNER

God has been very good to us! Our school enrollment numbers are continuing to grow, and we are currently anticipating between 170 - 180 students for next year. This would put us over 80% of our enrollment capacity of 220.

These estimates includes students in our additional Kindergarten class, which currently has a total of 30 kindergarten students registered for next year. (15 students in each class) This leaves room for 10 more students in Kindergarten.




