Another School Year Begins!

It's amazing, but this Tuesday will be the first day of school. As pastor of the Church of the Resurrection, I am excited about what God has in store for our parish, school, and community this year. Jacob Allstott and the wonderful team of teachers and staff members who make our Catholic school possible have been busily at work to prepare for another year of providing families an excellent Catholic school education here at Resurrection School. If you haven't yet had a chance to talk with Mr. Allstott about what we have in store this year, please contact him by email or by calling to the school office. He and the other members of our staff would be happy to give you a tour and answer any questions you have about the school including how affordable it can be for you and your family. We desire to partner with as many parents as possible in the spiritual, academic, and social formation of children, all of whom are precious to God our Father.

Returning to School Masses in the Time of Covid

We begin the new school year under restrictions from Governor Whitmer in terms of masks and "cohorting" our classrooms so that in the classroom the lower grade students are able to learn without masks. (Teachers will wear masks all day, except when they are eating.) Our plans at this point is to continue to have school Mass three days a week. However, attendance in the church will be restricted to students and staff of the school. Other parishioners and school family members will be asked to attend Mass in Mercy Hall, much like we have been doing on Saturday and Sunday. Our goal in this is to limit exposure to the virus for the school community as much as possible, so we can continue to keep the virus at bay, which we hope and pray will allow us to stay "in person" as long as possible. Please pray for that! I know that this will be an inconvenience for regular daily Mass goers, but we trust that this arrangement will work. We will see how this goes, and may make a change, if it becomes necessary.

Organ Repair

Most of you may already know this, but we have scheduled some major repairs to our Cassavant organ which is valued at \$750,000. We have had

problems with the electronic switches, and hope to get that fixed as soon as possible. The other work that is needed is the replacement of "leathers." The total cost for the needed repairs is approximately \$130,000. These repairs have been long needed, and we had hoped to have this work done earlier this year. But the uncertainties of Covid and the challenge of getting things scheduled has delayed this. If you are able, please consider giving a special donation (either by check or by online giving) to help us repair and maintain this great treasure in our city. Thank you!

I also want to take time to express yet again how grateful I am for your continued generous support of our ministry at the Church of the Resurrection, our school, and preschool. We are committed to being good stewards of the Lord's resources, and are seeking always to invest resources in ministry efforts that help us become disciples and minister in love to those in our community.

This Sunday, we have the great account of Simon's statement about Jesus, and the gift that Jesus gave him (and us) when he called him Peter. He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" Simon Peter said in reply, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Jesus said to him in reply, "Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah. For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my heavenly Father. And so I say to you, you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church, and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it.

May we value the great gift of the Church and trust that the "gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it," however bad things might get. The message this week, as the past few weeks, is trust. God has not abandoned us. Let us open our hearts to him in prayer and faith, striving always to love more God and our neighbors more and more and more.
