Thank you for your prayerful support of our ministry, and your commitment to spiritual growth, spreading the Gospel, and ministering to those in need. It is a beautiful thing to see the generous outpouring of time, talent, and treasure parishioners have shown, and the openness to the Lord's leading among the faithful of the parish. The Lord has blessed us richly, and I hope and pray that we will continue to grow in our ability to worship God well, grow in holiness, and serve others in love, especially the "least of these" as we enjoy the new year in our Lord's favor.

Come *Encounter* Jesus

This Saturday (December 12), we have our next *Healing Encounter*. It is a time of praise, worship, prayer, and adoration from 7:00 to 8:30 p.m. in the church. The focus this month will be *hope*. It's a great opportunity to worship God and to open our hearts to have Him do healing work in us. We will also stream the service, as we have been doing regularly of late. Come, and bring others with you. Prayer teams will be available in separate rooms with "distancing" to allow people to receive prayer for healing and other requests. Come, and invite someone to join you.

Reading in the New Year

Last week in the bulletin, I referenced three books/letters that I want to encourage parishioners to consider reading in the coming new year, and, should you desire, to join with others to read through the books. The two books I mentioned are *Live Not by Lies: A Manual for Christian Dissidents*, by Rod Dreher, and *A Church in Crisis: Pathways Forward*, by Ralph Martin. I also recommended reading through the US Conference of Catholic Bishops' pastoral letter on racism: *Open Wide Our Hearts: The Enduring Call to Love*. That letter can be downloaded from the USCCB website.

Generous Donation

After I mentioned those two books, a family in the parish has decided to donate copies of both of the books. We will get 300 copies of each book, and would ask that families please take just one copy per family of each title. I wanted to let you know that this donation has been made to save you from having to purchase it. I'm not sure how soon we will be able to get these titles, but I am very grateful for this generous gift.

Realigning Resources for Mission Committee Parish Meeting

Prior to the COVID shutdown in March, the committee that I am part of had planned to hold information meetings at every parish to share the bishop's vision and to get feedback from parishioners. We finally began conducting these meetings a few weeks ago. Our parish meeting, which is scheduled for Wednesday, December

16 at 7:00 p.m., will hopefully be able to be held in person in Mercy Hall, but the shut-down of public meetings might be extended. If that happens, we will hold the meeting virtually using Zoom. These meetings are ongoing, and I invite us all to please keep this process and all our brothers and sisters throughout the Diocese of Lansing in our prayers. We are striving to better fulfill the Lord's missionary mandate, and I'm grateful that we are taking seriously this opportunity to "Realign Resources for Mission."

Communal Penance Services Have Been Cancelled

The communal penance services that I announced last week have been cancelled. Special *Rorate Masses* December 15th & 19th at 7:00 a.m.

This coming week on both Tuesday and Saturday morning at 7:00 a.m., we will celebrate special *Rorate Masses* by candlelight in addition to our normal 8:15 a.m. Mass. The Rorate Caeli Mass is a traditional Advent devotion wherein the Mass of the Blessed Virgin Mary for Advent is offered just before dawn. The interplay of light and darkness speak to the meaning of Advent and the coming of the Light of the world.

The Mass takes its title, Rorate Caeli, from the first words of the Introit, which are from Isaiah 45:8: "Rorate, caeli, desuper, et nubes pluant justum, aperiatur terra, et germinet Salvatorem." "Drop down dew, ye heavens, from above, and let the clouds rain the just: let the earth be opened and bud forth a Savior."

The Rorate Mass is lit only by candlelight. Because it is a votive Mass in Mary's honor, white vestments are worn instead of Advent violet. In the dimly lit setting, priests and faithful prepare to honor the Light of the world, Who is soon to be born, and offer praise to God for the gift of Our Lady. As the Mass proceeds and sunrise approaches, the church becomes progressively brighter, illumined by the sun as our Faith is illumined by Christ. The readings and prayers of the Mass foretell the prophecy of the Virgin who would bear a Son called Emmanuel, and call on all to raise the gates of their hearts and their societies to let Christ the King enter; asking for the grace to receive eternal life by the merits of the Incarnation and saving Resurrection of Our Lord.
