Realigning Resources for Mission

As I wrote mentioned last week, over the past couple of years, in concert with the Realigning Resources for Mission (RRM) Committee, Bishop Boyea has made clear his vision for having every parish in the diocese be transformed so that it can effectively form missionary disciples. The goal, of course, is to fulfill the Great Commission. The four "pillars" of the bishop's vision for a healthy parish, are as follows: *A healthy parish in the Diocese of Lansing:*

- *is led by priests striving for health and holiness*
- *equips and empowers parish staff*
- *makes and forms missionary disciples*
- *and seeks the lost and serves the poor.*

It's a good vision, worth prayerfully striving to fulfill. We are doing all we can to move in this direction, and look forward to seeing this vision be realized throughout the ten counties of the Diocese of Lansing.

Reminder: RRM Meeting Tonight

This (Sunday) evening, beginning at 6:30 p.m., all interested members of the diocese are invited to join simultaneous meetings at the four diocesan high schools (or you can join by YouTube at 6:30 or anytime thereafter). As I mentioned last week, the meetings are intended to share with the people of God the proposals that the members of the Realigning Resources for Mission (RRM) Committee have developed. Those who plan to join us in person are invited to go to the diocesan RRM webpage to RSVP, so that we have a good sense of how many people plan to attend each of the four live events. Our local event will be held at Lansing Catholic in the auditorium (note the change of venue) next Sunday evening.

Adoration on Fridays

Thanks to all of you who spend time with Jesus on Fridays during adoration from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. You give a great gift of yourself and your time when you spend time in prayer before the Lord. Your prayer is a gift to the Lord, to our parish, and to our community. For all those reasons, I'm very grateful that we have been able to offer this day of adoration each week. Unfortunately, we are recently been struggling to get every hour covered by at least two people. As a result of having only one person per hour, staff

members having to call to get people to commit to fill the slots with at least one person. Please share the word that we need to have people commit to an hour each week, or we may not be able to continue to offer adoration until we get those commitments. It is too risky that people will need to leave without having someone who can take their place. We can't, of course, allow Jesus to be left alone on the altar!


