Pictorial Parish Directory Update

I have had some questions about the status of the Parish Directory, for obvious reasons. It is, indeed, much delayed. I won't lie to you, it's been a more challenging process than we expected. After some earlier frustrations, we had some good help from a parishioner with the front part of the directory. We are now in the process of proofing the names of the photo directory portion. We hope to have our proofing done this week. Then, we will ask for a final proof, which will take yet more time. We hope to have it done soon, but I won't hazard a guess as to when that might be. I apologize for the delays.

Catholic Youth Summer Camp

- 4) The weeks we have pre-ordered are for High School (rising 9-12 graders), Week 3 and Middle Schoolers (rising 6-8th graders) week 7. The results from the poll sent earlier were overwhelmingly in favor of week 7 for middle schoolers. (If your family would like to redeem the parish scholarship offer of \$100 towards each camper, please use the same code (RESLANSING) during the payment portion of registration.)

Deans and Deaneries

I wanted to include this again this week. The transition to having ten Deans with responsibilities for the parishes within "Deaneries" is a reorganization of the diocese, shifting from "Vicariates" with the goal of moving us all forward on our commitment to forming missionary disciples. A few people wondered if I would be leaving Resurrection. The answer is no. This set of responsibilities will be in addition to my role as pastor, just like all the other Deans. I see this as manageable, with collaboration from the priests of the Lansing Deanery and the support of the diocesan staff. The following are the expectations of the Dean, as outlined in Canon Law. Canon 555 of the Code of Canon Law lays out nicely the responsibilities for a dean. These includes:

- To promote and coordinate common pastoral activity
- To ensure that local clerics lead a life in keeping with their state
- To ensure that local clerics perform their duties diligently
- To ensure that religious functions are celebrated according to liturgical prescripts
- To ensure that the beauty and elegance of churches and sacred furnishings are maintained carefully, especially in the Eucharistic celebration and custody of the Eucharist
- To ensure that, according to particular law, clerics attend lectures, theological meetings, or conferences
- To take care that spiritual supports are available to presbyters of his district and to show concern for those who are in difficult circumstances or beset by problems.

I will be serving as Dean, beginning in July, of the "Lansing Deanery," which includes the following parishes and groups:

- Lansing North: Church of the Resurrection, St Andrew Dung-Lac, St Mary Cathedral, and St Therese.
- East Lansing/Shiawassee: St Mary, Morrice and St Thomas Aquinas (includes St. John Church & Student Center, East Lansing)
- Eastern Ingham: St Martha and St Mary, Williamston

Please pray for me, the other nine deans, and the entire diocese as we anticipate this new structure, which will go into effect in July. Come, Holy Spirit!
