Based on private spiritual revelations given to St. Faustina, on June 29, 2002, the Holy See promulgated a decree creating new indulgences that may be gained by the faithful in connection with the celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday. This decree grants a plenary indulgence to those who comply with all the conditions established, and a partial indulgence to those who incompletely fulfill the conditions. ### **The Peace of Forgiveness**

Today in our Gospel, Jesus appears to the Apostles, and says, "Peace be with you." That's His desire for each of us—that we would experience peace that surpasses human understanding. He said "Peace be with you" a second time, and then breathed on them, saying "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them; whose sins you retain are retained." In that special outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles, the Church sees the institution of the Sacrament of Penance. And He gave it to us the very day He rose from the dead—so much did He know our need! As a priest I know the power of the words of absolution; I've felt the impact as a penitent myself, and I've witnessed the freedom of other penitents when they have confessed their sins and received absolution. Divine Mercy is our hope!


