And, "... you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."*

### June is the Month of the Sacred Heart

This year, we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus on June 16. That next weekend, there will be an opportunity to consecrate your homes to the Sacred Heart of Jesus at 10:30 a.m. on June 18, after what is likely to be the 9:00 a.m. early Mass and before the 11:00 a.m. Mass. 
### The "Great Commission"

Today in the Gospel, Jesus gives His final commands to his disciples. 
