# Deanery Mission March 3-5 at St. Thomas Aquinas

The Lansing Deanery will host its first Deanery Mission "The Holy Spirit: The Presence, the Power, and the Promise." It will be held March 3-5, 2024 from 6:30 p.m.-8:30 p.m. at St. Thomas Aguinas in East Lansing, with Dr. Mary Healy as the presenter. Here's the summary of what it will entail: At Pentecost the Holy Spirit came down on the apostles and changed their lives forever. Throughout the history of the Church, the Holy Spirit has empowered miracleworkers, emboldened martyrs, and imbued the saints with the grace of heroic virtue. But who is the Holy Spirit? In this three-evening mission we will not only explore the nature of the Holy Spirit, but call on Him to heal us, open us to our own Pentecost, and equip us to live lives of holiness and love.
