We conclude the Octave of Easter today with the celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday. Saint John Paul II gave us this great Feast Day in response to the Lord's words to St. Faustina. The Lord is merciful! Indeed, *He is mercy*. There will be a celebration of Divine Mercy at St. Mary Cathedral today (April 7) at 2:30 p.m.

Divine Mercy Devotion & Indulgence

I invite everyone to investigate the beautiful teachings about the Divine Mercy, and to entrust themselves to Jesus, as St. Faustina did. Based on private spiritual revelations given to St. Faustina, on June 29, 2002, the Holy See promulgated a decree creating new indulgences that may be gained by the faithful in connection with the celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday. This decree grants a plenary indulgence to those who comply with all the conditions established, and a partial indulgence to those who incompletely fulfill the conditions. Last Sunday Before Renovation

As you likely already know, this is the last weekend that we will have Sunday Masses at the church. Next Sunday, Masses will be held at Lansing Catholic High School Chapel at 8:00 a.m., 9:30 a.m., and 11:30 a.m. (We will not offer Saturday or Sunday Evening Masses during the renovation.) Daily Masses and confessions will be held in Mercy Hall (enter by the main entrance off Rumsey). You can pick up a handout of other ramifications of the renovation at the exits this weekend. These changes will be in effect until the renovations have progressed far enough for us to use the church again, most likely be late August or September. (Some aspects of the renovation will not be completed by that time, but we will be able to use the church again.)

Our bimonthly Healing Encounter will be held next Saturday (April 13). Because renovations will have begun earlier that afternoon, the Encounter will be held in Mercy Hall at 7:00 p.m. It will be an evening of adoration and prayers for healing. We should be finished up around 8:30. Confession and prayer ministry will be available.

The Peace of Forgiveness

Today in our Gospel, Jesus appears to the Apostles, and says, "Peace be with you." That's His desire for each of us—that we would experience peace that surpasses human understanding. He said "Peace be with you" a second time, and then breathed on them, saying "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them; whose sins you retain are retained." In that special outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles, the Church sees the institution of the Sacrament of Penance. And He gave it to us the very day He rose from the dead—so much did He know our need! As a priest I know the power of the words of absolution; I've felt the impact as a penitent myself, and I've witnessed the freedom of other penitents when they have confessed their sins and received absolution. Divine Mercy is our hope!
