

Happy Fathers' Day!

Today, we celebrate our fathers. As pastor, I want to express my appreciation for fathers who model for their children (and all of us) the love of the Heavenly Father. Our culture has eroded the respect that fathers deserve, and I pray that Christian fathers will prayerfully look to our Father in heaven for the grace to live as witnesses of God's love in their homes, and in the world. I pray that mothers and children will honor fathers and respect them as they strive to be the fathers God longs for them to be. May God bless all fathers, whether biological or spiritual.

The Gift of the Priesthood

Last weekend, Fr. Joshua Fons and Fr. Riley O'Shea were ordained. This weekend, as we celebrate fathers, and just as we celebrated the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, this powerful reflection from St. John Vianney, patron of parish priests, from his *Catechism on the Priesthood* is worth reading: *Saint Bernard tells us that everything has come to us through Mary; and we may also say that everything has come to us through the priest; yes, all happiness, all graces, all heavenly gifts. If we had not the Sacrament of Orders, we should not have Our Lord. Who placed Him there, in that tabernacle? It was the priest. Who was it that received your soul, on its entrance into life? The priest. Who nourishes it, to give it strength to make its pilgrimage? The priest. Who will prepare it to appear before God, by washing that soul, for the last time, in the blood of Jesus Christ? The priest -- always the priest. And if that soul comes to the point of death, who will raise it up, who will restore it to calmness and peace? Again, the priest. You cannot recall one single blessing from God without finding, side by side with this recollection, the image of the priest.*

Vocations Are a Gift from God

I'm grateful for the men and women who have heard the call from God here at the Church of the Resurrection in the past. Their call has been heard because of what God has done in their hearts in and through our parish, and most especially within families where vocations are honored and discussed. We are grateful for the continuing process of discernment among Mason Abbott, Thomas Crowley, and Charlie Gates from our parish, as they discern their call to priesthood as seminarians. Thomas is studying at the North American College in Rome, and Mason will begin his first year of major seminary, at Sacred Heart Major Seminary in Detroit. Charlie is helping out at St. Mary Magdalene in Brighton and will continue his studies at SJV in St. Paul in the fall.

Please pray for them and for all those men whom the Lord is calling to the process of discernment. If a young (or not so young) man is wondering whether the Lord may be calling him to the priesthood, please invite them to make an appointment with me or another priest. The Lord calls, and we are happy to assist anyone in their initial process of discernment. The Lord loves an open heart, and I think it's valuable to remind everyone that attending seminary doesn't, of course, mean more than that one is pursuing/continuing discernment. For those who are ordained, the Lord's call becomes clearer over time, and is ratified interiorly and by the Church.

You can call or fill out that information using the form on our website. The form asks for names, addresses, phone numbers, and a contact number of a family member. Note: If your loved ones (or you yourself) are admitted to the hospital, please call the office (517.482.4749). You can leave a message with Sarah or you can dial extension 106, which will connect to my cell phone. Feel free at any time to dial extension 106 when there is an emergency and someone needs the sacrament of the sick (anointing).
