

Hearts Filled with Joy

On this *Gaudete Sunday*, my heart is filled with joy for God's goodness to us this year. Thank you for your prayerful support of our ministry, and your commitment to spiritual growth, spreading the Gospel, and ministering to those in need. It is a beautiful thing to see the generous outpouring of time, talent, and treasure parishioners have shown, and the openness to the Lord's leading among the faithful of the parish. This year we rejoice in the fruition of the church renovation, and look forward to the dedication of the altar in January. Indeed, the Lord has blessed us richly, and I hope and pray that we will continue to grow in our ability to worship God well, grow in holiness, and serve others in love, especially the "least of these" as we enjoy the new year in our Lord's favor.

Come Encounter Jesus

This evening (Saturday, December 14th), we will have our next *Healing Encounter*. It is a time of praise, worship, prayer, and adoration from 7:00 to 8:30 p.m. in the church. It's a great opportunity to worship God and to open our hearts to have Him do healing work in us. Come, and bring others with you. Prayer teams will be available to pray for healing and other requests. Come, and invite someone to join you.

Special Rorate Masses December 18th & 21st, 7a.m.

Wednesday and Saturday mornings at 7:00 a.m., we will celebrate special Rorate Masses by candlelight in addition to our normal Masses.

The Rorate Caeli Mass is a traditional Advent devotion wherein the Mass of the Blessed Virgin Mary for Advent is offered just before dawn. The interplay of light and darkness speak to the meaning of Advent and the coming of the Light of the world. The Mass takes its title, Rorate Caeli, from the first words of the Introit, which are from Isaiah 45:8: "Rorate, caeli, desuper, et nubes pluant justum, aperiatur terra, et germinet Salvatorem." "Drop down dew, ye heavens, from above, and let the clouds rain the just: let the earth be opened and bud forth a Saviour." The Rorate Mass is lit only by candlelight. Because it is a votive Mass in Mary's honor, white vestments are worn instead of Advent violet. In the dimly lit setting, priests and faithful prepare to honor the Light of the world, Who is soon to be born, and offer praise to God for the gift of Our Lady. As the Mass proceeds and sunrise approaches, the church becomes progressively brighter, illumined by the sun as our Faith is illumined by Christ. The readings and prayers of the Mass foretell the prophecy of the Virgin who would bear a Son called Emmanuel, and call on all to raise the gates of their hearts and their societies to let Christ the King enter; asking for the grace to receive eternal life by the merits of the Incarnation and saving Resurrection of Our Lord.

Women's Advent Retreat

All women of the parish, middle school and up are invited to attend an Advent Retreat on Saturday, December 21st. The retreat will begin with Mass with the parish, and then move over to Mercy Hall for refreshments, followed by a couple of presentations on the theme of "Maintaining Peace in the Middle of Life's Challenges." There are many options available.

Rejoice in the Lord Always

This week, our second reading is taken from St. Paul's Letter to the Philippians, and it gives us wonderful instructions that are perfectly suited to Gaudete Sunday:

Rejoice in the Lord always. I shall say it again: rejoice! Your kindness should be known to all. The Lord is near. Have no anxiety at all, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, make your requests known to God. Then the peace of God that surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. If we follow Paul's exhortations, choosing—for it is always a choice—to rejoice, we will live lives of kindness that is "known to all." Those who rejoice are not those who look for things to criticize but rather look for things to encourage and celebrate. That's a great path forward in life and in love. Of course, our lives are marked by things that could (if we let them) cause us anxiety. But the Lord himself, and through St. Paul in this text, says "Have no anxiety at all." He commands that repeatedly because Jesus is always near. (Wherever we are, Jesus is, for we live in Him and He in us!) Instead of anxiety, we are called to make all our burdens and concerns, by prayer and petition, known to God. And the "payoff" follows: Then (note: only then!) the peace of God that surpasses all understanding will guard our hearts and minds. So, as Christmas draws near, let's trust Jesus and St. Paul in this, rejoicing as we go.






Women's Advent Retreat


