#### As the School Year Draws to a Close . . .

This coming Friday will be the last day of school for the year. As pastor, I am very grateful for the support the parish has long provided our school, and I am indebted to our principal, Mr. Jacob Allstott, and the excellent faculty and staff who make our school the wonderful place of social, academic, and spiritual formation that it is. As it says on our school letterhead, we've been "forming disciples of Christ since 1926." We're closing in on 100 years for our school. Thanks be to God. Go Shamrocks! Please pray for our faculty, staff, parents, and students. Be sure of this, our parish's long-standing investment in Resurrection School has borne fruit and is bearing good fruit still. Thank you.

#### Come, Holy Spirit!

This past Tuesday, we had the graduation Mass for the 8th graders. I celebrated a Votive Mass for the Holy Spirit, to call blessings down upon the graduates and their family and friends who were gathered in prayer. I reminded them of the great vision statement for the diocese that Bishop Boyea gave us years ago, when we prayed as a diocese and parish the "Come, Holy Spirit" prayer. The preface of the prayer is one that is worth recalling, as we enter into a season of rest, renewal, and (for many) travel hither and yon: Let us pray that every person within the Catholic Diocese of Lansing will come to know and love our Lord Jesus Christ in a personal way, grow in maturity as a disciple of Christ, become actively engaged in the full life of the Church, and joyfully utilize his or her gifts for the building up the Kingdom of God and the salvation of souls. We continue to pray for that purpose, and I invite you to daily or weekly pray the "Come, Holy Spirit!" prayer to guide our efforts. After all, the Holy Spirit is the One who is

building our house, our school, our ministry here. Let us continue to faithfully call out, "Come, Holy Spirit," trusting the Lord's guidance as we proceed. The Lord has given you gifts, and God desires you to know them and employ them for the building up of the Kingdom of God. Please prayerfully discern how you can become more involved in the life of the parish and the Church, especially outside the doors of the church building.


#### **Memorial Day Mass**


