### It's Pentecost. Come, Holy Spirit!

Today, we pray for the Holy Spirit to come . . . fill the hearts of the faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love . . . Just what we've been praying, for years. As I've said more than a few times over the past years, "Come, Holy Spirit" is a prayer that the Holy Spirit can't resist. He comes! May we be those who open our hearts to receive with an open heart, mind, and will the power of the Holy Spirit.

### The Holy Spirit Changes Everything

Our Catholic faith teaches us that the Holy Spirit changes everything, at least those "things" that are willing to be changed (including us)! Countless men and women (boys and girls) have experienced the transformational change that the Lord offers us through the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. St. Ignatius of Laodicea drafted these powerful words, which struck me the first time I heard them, and impress me still:

#### WITHOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT,

God is distant, Christ stays in the past, the Gospel is a dead letter, the Church is simply an organization, authority a matter of domination, mission a matter of propaganda, the liturgical services no more than a reminder of the past, Christian living a slave morality.

### BUT WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT,

God is with us, the universe is resurrected and groans with the birth pangs of the kingdom, the risen Christ is here, the Gospel is the power of life, the Church is the organism, the Body of the living Christ, authority is service, mission is Pentecost, the liturgy is both memorial and anticipation, human action is God at work in this world.

Take some time this coming week to muse about why St. Ignatius would say such wondrous things about the Holy Spirit's effects in our world, hearts, and lives.

### **40 Hours Devotion (Adoration)**

Throughout the diocese, deaneries have arranged for times at every parish to spend in adoration. Our parish time for the 40 hours is this coming week, beginning at 3:30 p.m. on Thursday, June 12, and will run through 7:30 a.m. Saturday, June 14. You can sign-up for an hour (or more) of adoration on

our website. We would love to have at least two people for each hour of adoration. (The Blessed Sacrament, of course, will be reposed for Mass times, and exposed afterward.)

### Feast of Corpus Christi Mass & Procession with Bishop Boyea

Bishop Earl Boyea invites you to join him and clergy from around the Diocese on June 21 at 10:00am for Mass at Jackson Field (home of the Lansing Lugnuts) and will then lead a procession with the Blessed Sacrament from Jackson Field to the steps of the State Capitol (0.5 miles). 
### **Meet Father Brett Ivey**


