#### **Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles**

During "Ordinary Time," whenever a Feast or Solemnity falls on Sunday, it takes precedence over the normal Sunday to be celebrated. This Sunday would have been the Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, but we will hear the proper readings for the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul. Both of them were martyred c. 67 A.D., Paul by beheading and Peter by crucifixion. They offered their lives in testimony to the Risen Christ. The altars of the two great Basilicas (St. Peter's and St. Paul Outside the Walls) are placed over their graves. They are the foremost Apostles, St. Peter, the first pope and apostle to the Jews, and St. Paul, apostle to the Gentiles. We are grateful to have them flanking the central panel of our rerodos: St. Paul to the left and St. Peter to the right. Saints Peter and Paul, pray for us!

#### LAST CALL for 2025 Offertory Challenge

At this writing (Wednesday, June 25), about 60 of you have filled out one of the Offertory Challenge cards or filled out the response online. (Others may have increased their online giving and not filled out the form. If that's you, would you please do so? That would be helpful.) One of those who filled out the form said they will need to decrease their giving and a few said they are not able to increase their giving at this time. Some have decided to double their giving, others have made increased as low as \$2 per week. Thank you all.

#### **Should We Call?**

We'd love to get feedback from everyone so that we know that everyone has heard and responded to the call to prayerful discern the Lord's leading in their hearts and homes. Most of you have not responded . . yet. Non-responses make me wonder if we should call, but I'm not so inclined. I can't help but wonder if the message has "gotten through" or if people are concerned that money is not being spent wisely, or something else. (NB: If you have questions or concerns, please reach out to me. Some of you have done that. Thanks.) I suspect that many, if not most, of those who have not followed through on my request are simply busy and haven't gotten around

it. I understand. All of us in 2025 are too busy. Even so, if you would, please take some time, pray about it, and let us know. It will help us as we finalize our budget for 2025-2026. Thank you again.

#### **Budget Realities**

Given our need to replace the roof on at least one of the school buildings (at a cost of \$185,000 per roof), even with an expected increase in offertory (thank you!), we have decided to pull back from some of our programatic "extras." None of the items that we are eliminating is really very expensive, but as you all know well, every dollar adds up. After the following (and more) changes, we have a balanced budget, not counting the \$185,000 for one roof replacement. We have funds in savings that we will use, since delaying further would cause further damage, and costlier repairs.

#### **Magazine and Podcast**

We will be canceling the Resurrection Magazine and the Resurrection Life Podcast, at least for now, and two of our parish staff members will have reduced hours moving forward. I want to publicly thank Sean O'Neill, Mary Gates, and Sarah Fink, who work on the content, editing, and layout for our magazine. It was great while it lasted. Perhaps sometime in the future we'll be able to bring it back. We're also canceling the Resurrection Life Podcast, which owes much to Sean O'Neill, Debbie McPherson who ensures things get pulled together, and Rich Budd, with whom I talk a bit each episode. I've enjoyed it, and will miss the bi-weekly banter with Rich. The podcast began on March 10, 2021, so we've had a four year run of Resurrection Life Podcast! Thank you all.

#### **Independence Day**

Mass will be at 8:15 a.m., as usual, on Friday, July 4th. We will have the church open, but we will not have exposition through the day. There will be a Holy Hour and confessions from 5:30 to 6:30 p.m., concluding with Benediction. Please pray for our nation, especially that our Religious Liberties will be respected long into the future. Have a blessed and enjoyable Fourth!


#### **Catholic Charities Baby Shower**


