We come to the end of our Liturgical Year by celebrating the Reign of God manifest in Jesus Christ our Lord and King. Our entire life as Christians is ordered to hope and anticipation of Christ's return and our own fellowship with Him in Heaven. Our home is in Heaven, and the King who is to come again is our Brother, our Savior, and our Friend, and our Lord. If we walk always by His side, following Him, accompanying Him in our daily choices, we have no reason to fear His return. He will welcome us into His Father's House.

Advent Begins Next Sunday

What a great transition we find at this time of year! Right after we celebrate Christ's Kingship, we begin to anticipate His coming in three ways: His Incarnation (coming as a baby for us); His coming again in glory; and His coming in our hearts. It is a holy season of anticipation. To assist you in your preparation, please take a booklet filled with meditations for each day of Advent. May we all enter deeply into this great season of hope. Feel free to take a copy of the *Magnificat Advent Companion*, at the various exits.

Stewardship for Saints and Scholars (S3)

We are going to be wrapping up the S3 campaign next weekend, and this weekend and next, there will be pledge cards in the pews for all those who have yet to respond to the appeal to make a gift of pledge. Thank you to all who have already prayed about their gift and those who have made a gift/ pledge to the campaign. I've made a gift/pledge myself, and would be happy to answer any questions any of you might have about the campaign, its purposes and goals, and our part in the campaign. As I've mentioned before, I don't want anyone to feel coerced into giving, but I do invite all of us to prayerfully consider the goals of the campaign, and follow the Lord's leading with regard to a potential gift. As I've mentioned before, the letter from the bishop with a particular amount that you are being asked to give is an aspirational amount, rather than an expectation. Some will be able (and choose) to give that amount, some may discern that they are called to give less. Some may feel called to give more than the amount requested. A few of you have already

told me that you (and your families) are unable to give or pledge anything more than your committed giving at this time. Be assured of this: I respect your discernment. I simply merely ask everyone to prayerfully consider the elements of the campaign, and then respond to the Lord's leading. (Thanks in advance!) Should you not have received a letter, you can get a pledge card from Sarah Michaels at the parish office. One final note: If you haven't seen the video for the S3 campaign yet, it's quite good. 
