Christmas & New Year's Mass Schedule

On Christmas Eve, we will have Masses at 5:00 and Midnight (prelude music will commence at 11:30 p.m.). On Christmas Day, there will be one Mass at 10:00 a.m. Next Sunday, we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Holy Family at the usual times. After that, on the Eighth Day (the Octave) of Christmas, which is January 1, we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of God. We will have a Vigil Mass at 5:00 p.m. December 31. We will have a second Mass that evening at 10:30 p.m., followed by adoration, with Benediction just prior to Midnight. New Year's Day we will have one Mass at 10:00 a.m. If those times won't work for you, please check with surrounding parishes to begin the new year well, by praising our Lord. Please note that our offices will be closed December 24-26. Offices will also be closed next week December 31 st through January 2nd . If you are traveling, may you enjoy the protection of your guardian angels, and have a joyous celebration with your family and friends. God bless you all.

Special Event: Twelfth Night

On January 10th, we will celebrate our annual Twelfth Night Celebration. Doors will open after the evening Mass and the program will begin at 6:30 p.m. It's a celebration of the great gift of Christ's manifestation at Christmas and Epiphany. Adults in the parish and friends are invited to join us for an evening of songs, music, and poetry that will inspire and entertain in equal measure. The Twelfth Night has been a traditional celebration since before medieval times, particularly in Europe, and involves the consumption of abundant food and drink as well as performances to honor the birth of our Savior.
