Diocesan Services Appeal Commitment Weekend

This week is "commitment weekend" for DSA. As I mentioned last week, our 2026 Diocesan Services Campaign goal is \$117,566. The goal has stayed basically the same for the past three years, in part because of a new formula that I helped the diocese develop a few years ago. As always, I invite every household to prayerfully discern their own response to this appeal from the bishop. The cause is, I believe, one worth supporting, and I invite everyone to prayerfully consider making a pledge or gift. As always, some will be unable to add much if anything to their existing giving, but others of us are able to make a gift or pledge. As I say every year, I hope that we can have a good percentage of our parishioners give a gift. Percentage of households is a good proxy for our support for Bishop Boyea. If we have a high percentage, I trust that our giving will get close to our goal. Please prayerfully discern your gift. You can fill out the form online or drop the envelope in the offertory. Thank you in advance.

Diocesan-Wide Survey

Every adult in parishes across the diocese is invited to complete an online (or paper) survey called "Disciple-Maker Index." This survey will provide helpful data to assess the current climate and health of the diocese (and parishes in the diocese). We will get data comparing our parish with others in the diocese, and with national averages. The survey takes 10 to 15 minutes to complete, and the results will be invaluable to me, the staff, and our many volunteers as we seek ways to best support everyone in their discipleship journey. There is a link on our website. You can get printed copies of the survey by talking with Sarah Michaels at the office or asking Fr. Steve after Masses.

Totus Tuus (in place of VBS, June 22-26*)

This year, instead of the normal Vacation Bible School program that we have used in past years, we will be hosting *Totus Tuus*, which is a deeply Catholic opportunity for

students young and old to focus on God's love. We will host student missionaries for the week who will work with grade school students Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. and programming for middle and high school students Sunday (June 21*) through Thursday evenings from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. Rachel Hurst will be coordinating the support of the missionaries during the day, and we are looking for an individual or couple to support the missionaries for the evening (middle school and high school) programming. Please reach out to me if you are interested in learning more about what this would entail. Rachel will be looking for volunteers for the day sessions, as usual. The dates this year are June 22-26 (starting June 21 in the evening for the middle and high school track). Stay tuned for further updates and invitations to help with the program in the next month. Please pray for the missionaries who will be leading the program here, and for the students and families who will be involved.

Pilgrimage to Rome and Shrines of Italy is a Go!

This past week, some of you received an email from me about concerns regarding responsiveness from the company with whom I had arranged the pilgrimage. I'm grateful to say that the owner was very responsive and heard my concerns. He gave me contact information of four groups who have used them for their pilgrimages, and my concerns were all addressed. One of the priests is doing two more pilgrimages with Catholic Journeys this year. I feel confident that the pilgrimage will go well, and feel no more reason for the caution I emailed about. The occasion for the pilgrimage is the diaconate ordination of Thomas Crowley, a third year Seminarian studying at the North American College in Rome from our parish. Thomas will, God-willing, be ordained to the transitional diaconate on October 1, 2026 at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. Bishop Robert Barron will be the ordaining bishop for Thomas and his classmates. Fr. Vincent Richardson is planning to join us. You can find out more information (and register) at their website (<https://www.catholicjourneys.com/mattson/>) Password is "Mattson". Here are highlights of the trip, in addition, of course, to the ordination and Thomas's first Mass as a deacon: *Papal Audience with Pope Leo XVI, Vatican Museums and Sistine Chapel, Major Roman Basilicas, Padre Pio, St. Michael's Cave, Assisi - St. Francis, St. Clare, St. Carlo Acutis, Siena - St. Catherine, Eucharistic Miracle in Lanciano, The "Veronica" in Manoppello, and the Holy Family House in Loreto*. Daily Mass, breakfast and dinner are included every day. Consider joining us! **NB: I was thinking about having an informational meeting before Easter, but Sundays after the 11:00 a.m. Mass are busy between now and Easter. Please reach out to me (or the company) with questions about the pilgrimage.**
