2nd Scrutiny

Last weekend, I referenced the powerful prayer for the 2nd Scrutiny, which resonated powerfully with the readings from last Sunday, which were focused on seeing with the eyes of the Spirit. As I mentioned, this is a great prayer that we can (and should) pray for ourselves as well:

Father of mercy, you led the man born blind to the kingdom of light through the gift of faith in your Son. Free these elect from the false values that surround and blind them. Set them firmly in your truth, children of the light forever. Through Christ our Lord. We are surrounded by false values, and we need the Holy Spirit and the insights of scripture to help us see as God sees. Lord, open our eyes that we may see.

Descendants

Last Sunday, I used the recent Lansing Catholic High School production, which was, as I mentioned, really well acted and produced, as an example of seeing values that

are not consistent with our values as Catholic Christians. I hoped to convey pride in those who performed and helped others perform well while at the same time highlighting the problematic elements of the musical. I've conveyed those concerns to the leadership of Lansing Catholic, and Dominic Iocco, the President, has confirmed that they are committed to have a different and better vetting process for shows in future years. I'm grateful for that. Thanks also for those who sent emails or reached out to me to support me in preaching what was surely for some a difficult homily to hear. Let's keep praying for each other and the leadership of all our Catholic schools. Thanks!

Mass Times

For quite a few years, I have been celebrating four “Sunday Masses,” one at 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, and three on Sundays. You may recall that we eliminated the 5:00 p.m. Saturday Mass prior to Covid, but we brought that back as the “Covid-cautious Mass” after everyone returned to Mass in person. Though I thought years ago (and still believe) that it would be ideal to have a Sunday evening Mass in our Parish Group (St. Mary Cathedral, St. Andrew Dung Lac, and St. Therese), none of our parishes has an associate, which makes four Masses more feasible. The Church does not look well upon a priest celebrating three Masses on any day, except for All Souls Day. As a result, I will be eliminating the Sunday 5:00 p.m. Mass, effective April 19th. The last Sunday 5:00 p.m. Mass will be on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 12th. NB: Easter Sunday there will be no Sunday 5:00 p.m. Mass, as usual. I know that this will be an inconvenience for some of you, and I wish we could find another solution. But I know that our Saturday 5:00 p.m. Mass has more attending and most of them are regular parishioners. The Sunday 5:00 p.m., for obvious reasons, pulls in, as they say, people from the broader area. For those who are wondering about other options, masstimes.org can help you find times. At this time, St. John's Student Center has a 7:00 p.m. Mass throughout the MSU school year, St. Martha's has a 5:00 p.m., and St. Gerard has a 6:00 p.m. on Sundays. Please spread the word to those who might not otherwise hear. Thank you.

Penance Service on Monday March 23

The Lansing North Parish Group will have a communal penance service at St. Therese Monday, March 23rd, beginning at 6:30 p.m. There will be multiple priests available to hear confessions following a brief Liturgy of the Word. Area parishes have quite a few opportunities for confession throughout the week. Take advantage of one of those times as we get closer to Holy Week.


