Holiest of Weeks . . .

Today, we recall Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem. We honor Jesus too, waiving our own palms of victorious celebration, with the poignant awareness of what Jesus came to Jerusalem to do for us—die! And then, Praised be Jesus Christ, rise again. This entire week is one long meditation on love and discipleship. Give yourself, your family, your friends a great gift and join us as often as possible. Holy Week is a great gift to us, and we are exceedingly blessed as we spend time in prayer and gratitude this week.

Sacred Triduum

This Thursday, we begin the "Sacred Triduum," or the Holy Three Days. Note that there are no Masses Thursday, Friday, or Saturday mornings, because the Sacred Triduum forms a great liturgical whole. During the day on Thursday, my brother priests and I will gather with the Bishop of Lansing for the blessing of the Holy Oils and for the renewal of our priestly vows. In the evening, we will celebrate the institution of the Eucharist and priesthood at the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 6:30 p.m.

Eucharistic Procession to the Altar of Repose

After communion that evening, we will process with the Blessed Sacrament to the Altar of Repose, which will be in the parish hall, where the faithful are invited to spend time with Jesus (ending at 11:00 p.m.). Note that adoration will be available Friday morning from 8:00 a.m. until 2:30 at the Altar of Repose (again, in the parish hall).

Good Friday of the Lord's Passion

On Friday, there will be many opportunities to pray together. The Church's liturgy of the Lord's Passion will be held at **3:00 p.m.** Note the time change for that, which conforms with the expectation of the Church for this celebration. For the second time in a week, we will recall together the Passion of Our Lord Jesus Christ. We will also pray for our needs and the needs of the world, in the context of Christ's love poured out. We will then venerate the wood of the cross and receive Holy Communion. Finally, in the evening, we will pray the Stations of the Cross at 6:30 p.m.

Holy Saturday Night: The Easter Vigil

We spend the day on Holy Saturday in quiet silence and prayer as we recall Christ lying in the tomb for us. That evening, we will celebrate the Easter Vigil, which is the greatest Solemnity of the liturgical year. We will gather outside at dark, and begin the Solemn Vigil at 8:30 p.m. We will begin outside at the fire which represents Christ's triumph over death, and then process into the church, following the Paschal Candle.

Christ is our Light, and we are enlightened by Him. If you have not attended an Easter Vigil, plan to come. For the first time since I've been here, we will do all the Old Testament Readings, along with the accompanying Psalms. The Easter Vigil is a glorious celebration of the love of God and the power of Christ (and those baptized into Christ) over death. Come, let us worship!

Easter Celebration (After the Vigil)

Join us in celebrating our parish Patronal Feast Day after the Easter Vigil in Mercy Hall. Join us in congratulating the new Catholics, and those who received Easter Sacraments, as well as celebrating together the Resurrection. You can sign-up to help us set up for this on our website. Thank you!

Easter Sunday: The Resurrection of the Lord

Easter Sunday we will have two Masses at the usual times: 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. It will be a jubilant time of celebration of our Hope in Christ. Plan to come, and invite your friends and family to join you as we celebrate the great gift that death could not keep Him down. Please note that we will NOT have our typical 5:00 p.m. Sunday evening Mass on Easter.

Mass Time Change (Effective 4/19)

For reasons I outlined last week, the Sunday 5:00 p.m. Mass will be eliminated, effective April 19th. The last Sunday 5:00 p.m. Mass will be on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 12th. NB: Easter Sunday there will be no Sunday 5:00 p.m. Mass, as usual. I am sorry for the inconvenience for many of you, but I am not supposed to celebrate as many Masses as I have for years on Sunday. For those who are wondering about other options, masstimes.org can help you find times. At this time, St. John's Student Center has a 7:00 p.m. Mass throughout the MSU school year, St. Martha's has a 5:00 p.m., and St. Gerard has a 6:00 p.m. on Sundays. Please spread the word to those who might not otherwise hear. Thank you.

Being an "Inviting Parish"

Do you have family or friends who don't practice their faith, are dealing with serious challenges, seem to be frustrated with life, or are seeking the answers to the meaning of life? If so, the first step is praying for them. Ask the Lord for a sense of peace about inviting them to join you during Holy Week, or at some occasion during the season of Easter. As we enter into Holy Week, let's keep each other in prayer, as well as those that the Lord is placing on our hearts this Lent and Easter. God bless you all.

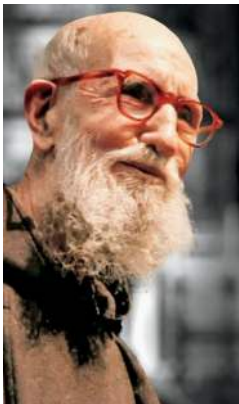
