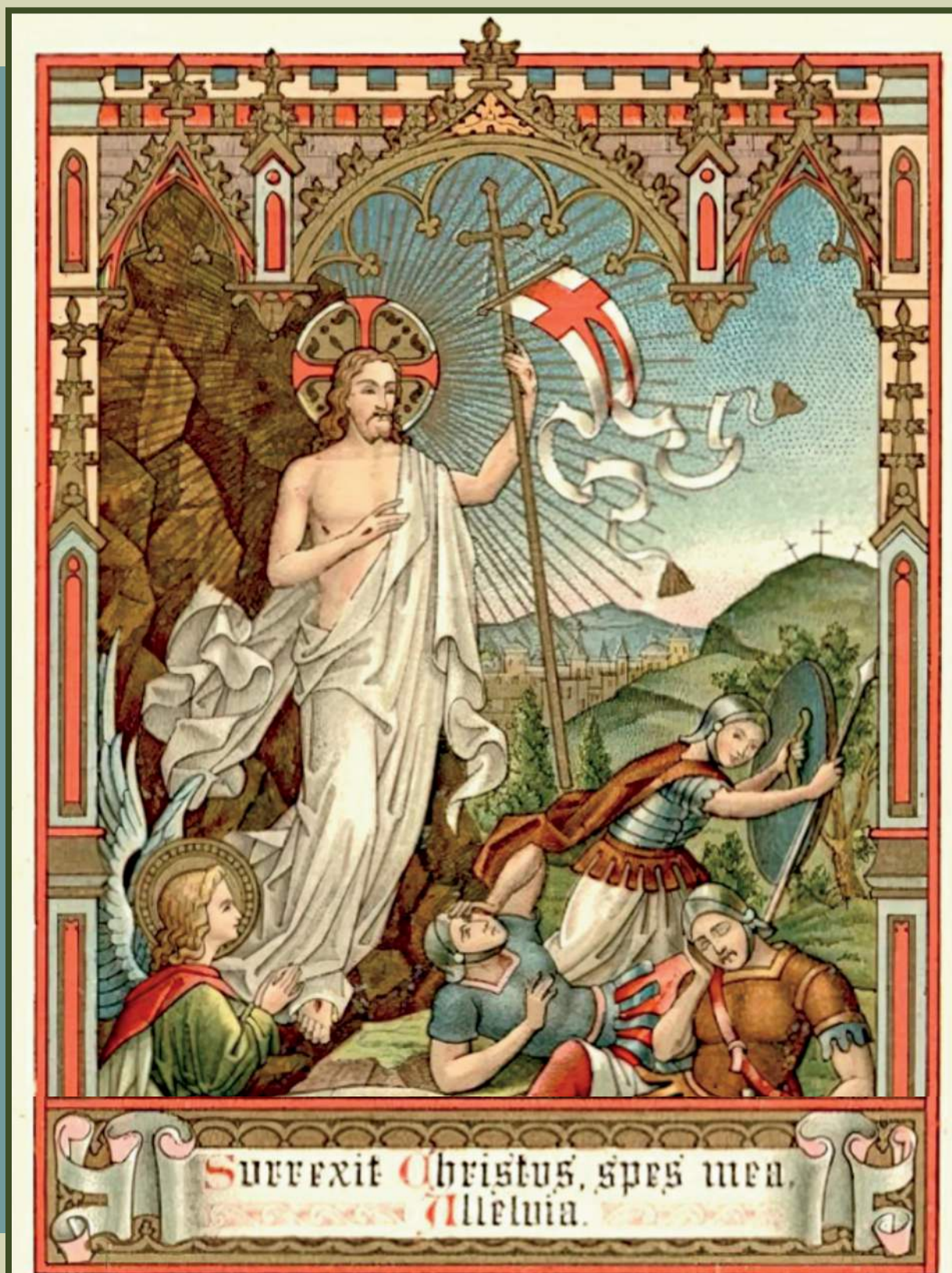

**Totus Tuus—The New VBS**

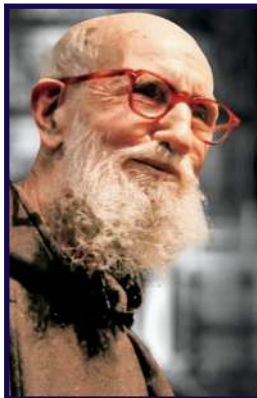
