Prayer for Peace

Pope Leo has invited the entire Church to pray for peace in the world, most especially at this time in light of the circumstances entailed with the Iran war. Though we are not bound to agree with every prudential decision or policy recommendation that this or any other pope recommends, we do well always to take seriously the Holy Father’s encouragement to pray, and work, for peace. We are commanded by God to pray for all authorities. At this time it is wise to pray for wisdom and grace, and, as the Holy Father has asked, that we pray for peace that accords with the truth, honors human dignity, and strives to attain the true common good.

The Liturgical Power of the “Road to Emmaus”

This Sunday, we have Luke’s powerful account of the conversation of the disciples and Jesus on the Road to Emmaus. We see in this account a beautiful picture of what happens to us every time we gather as believers to celebrate the Mass. Like them, we ask Jesus to open the scriptures for us so we can understand. Then, after that, as the gospel reads today, *‘And it happened that, while he was with them at table, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them. With that their eyes were opened and they recognized him, but he vanished from their sight. Then they said to each other, “Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the Scriptures to us?”’* Let our hearts and minds and lives be transformed by this profound encounter with Jesus in word and sacrament.
