Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

This Sunday, we remember the relationship of love that is the Most Holy Trinity. May we be drawn ever deeper into the life of love by yielding to the promptings of the Holy Spirit, seeking always to do the will of the Father through Jesus Christ our Lord!

Corpus Christi Procession Next Sunday

Next Sunday, we celebrate the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, or *Corpus Christi*. It is a time for us to truly rejoice in God's presence among us, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. After the 11:00 Mass, we will have a Eucharistic Procession, singing songs of praise to Jesus, our Eucharistic Lord. We will process around the block. Please plan to join us for this procession with the Eucharist exposed in a monstrance, with the faithful processing and singing songs of worship to Jesus who we believe is truly present in the Most Blessed Sacrament. May the Lord have mercy on us and bless as we lift Him high in our neighborhood and parish.

June is the Month of the Sacred Heart

The Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus is celebrated on the Friday after the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. This year, that will be June 12. *On June 16, 1675, Jesus told Sister Margaret Mary to promote a feast that honored his Sacred Heart. He also gave Sister Margaret Mary 12 promises made to all who venerate and promote the devotion of the Sacred Heart:*

1. *I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.*
2. *I will give peace in their families.*
3. *I will console them in all their troubles.*
4. *I will be their refuge in life and especially in death.*
5. *I will abundantly bless all their undertakings.*
6. *Sinners shall find in my heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.*
7. *Tepid souls shall become fervent.*
8. *Fervent souls shall rise speedily to great perfection.*
9. *I will bless those places wherein the image of my Sacred Heart shall be exposed and venerated.*
10. *I will give to priests the power to touch the most hardened hearts.*
11. *Persons who propagate this devotion shall have their names eternally written in my heart.*
12. *In the excess of the mercy of my heart, I promise you that my all-powerful love will grant to all*

those who will receive Communion on the first Fridays, for nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance: they will not die in my displeasure, nor without receiving the sacraments; and my heart will be their secure refuge in that last hour.

Those are tremendous promises. Let us take Jesus at His word, and honor the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus this month and every month.

Moving Forward and Staffing Changes

As we have come to the end of the current school year and anticipate another one in the fall, I will be taking some time to discern with our current leadership team and staff how to best fulfill the mission we have here in the heart of the city. This past week, I took some time on retreat to discern the Lord's leading, and will continue to do that over the next month or so. Sara DeWitt, who had served as our part-time Director of Parish Operations, has discerned that she won't be returning to that position after this past year's leave of absence. Liz O'Neill, after years with the parish and an earlier year of teaching at Lansing Catholic High School, has accepted a position to teach Freshman Theology at Lansing Catholic High School in the fall. I am grateful to both Sara and Liz for their service to the Lord, to our parish, and to me and other members of the Leadership Team. After a period of prayer and discernment, I will be posting at least one job description. Please pray for us in this period of discernment and transition. Thanks again to Sara and Liz for their partnership with me in ministry.
