Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

Today, we celebrate this great Solemnity, which announces to the world our devotion to Jesus, truly present in the Blessed Sacrament, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. Our liturgies owe a tremendous amount to St. Thomas Aquinas, a Dominican priest and Doctor of the Church. He was brilliant and prayerful and he handed on to us the fruits of his contemplation, in true Dominican fashion. St. Thomas had a mystical experience while celebrating mass on December 6, 1273, a few months before his death, after which he stopped writing the *Summa*. Despite the genius and wisdom of his writing, after the glimpse he was given of the beauty and glory in a vision, he said "I cannot go on . . . All that I have written seems to me like so much straw compared to what I have seen and what has been revealed to me." On another occasion, Jesus spoke to him from the crucifix, saying, "You have written well of me, Thomas! What do you desire?" To which, Thomas replied, "*Non nisi te, Domine.*" Only you, Lord (Jesus). May our hearts and minds be like unto St. Thomas Aquinas, that after an offer from the Lord of anything, we would wisely choose "nothing but Jesus." For, having Him, we have ALL.

Missionary Discipleship

As I mentioned in my homilies on Sunday morning last week, my time away was spent reflecting on and asking for the Lord's leading in terms of how to be more effective as a parish in terms of equipping every member of the parish to become "missionary disciples." Fr. James Mallon, who wrote a book on parish renewal called, *Divine Renovation* offers the following elements of what his parish (St. Benedict's) discerned was true of missionary disciples. They wrote:

A Missionary Disciple . . .

- *Has a personal relationship with Jesus*
- *Can and does share faith with others*
- *Is open to the gifts of the Holy Spirit*
- *Has knowledge and love of the Scriptures*
- *Knows basic Catholic theology*
- *Has a daily prayer life*
- *Experiences real "Christian Community"*
- *Has a commitment to Sunday Eucharist*
- *Celebrates the Sacrament of Reconciliation*
- *Can pray spontaneously out loud when asked*
- *Serves in ministry*
- *Sees his or her life as a mission field*

At the 9:00 a.m. Mass, I also discussed the following practices that I believe are vital for us to establish and that we are going to promote and foster over the next year to help us create a culture of missionary discipleship. The following list was developed by *Evangelical Catholic*, and it corresponds very well to what the Lord has been stirring in my heart. If we can cultivate these practices, I'm convinced that we ourselves will grow in maturity as Christians and spread the Good News, and form together the culture of missionary discipleship that will bear rich fruit. Many of us are practicing many of these, but I think all of us can grow in our discipleship, and I hope and pray that we will all respond to the Lord's leading in these areas. Please keep praying for wisdom for me and for our leadership team and staff. Thank you!

1. *Pray from the Heart: Draw close to God in the intimate dialogue of daily prayer.*
2. *Dwell in God's Word: Encounter God's living and active Word through meditation on Scripture.*
3. *Grow in Freedom: Seek healing in the Sacrament of Reconciliation and grow in detachment from sin.*
4. *Worship the Lord: Give praise and honor to God, especially through the celebration of the Eucharist.*
5. *Love Your Neighbor: Serve others with the compassion of Jesus.*
6. *Encourage One Another: Draw strength from a community of disciples who support each other and spur one another onward.*
7. *Follow God's Lead: Discern the Holy Spirit's promptings and respond to the Lord's guidance in your life.*
8. *Call on Mary and the Saints: Follow the saints toward a fully transformed life in Jesus.*
9. *Entrust Your Life to Jesus: Rely on God in every circumstance: big and small, joyful and sorrowful, life and death.*
10. *Share the Good News: Witness to the saving power of God in your actions and words.*
