**Join Us for Thomas's Ordination**

Thomas Crowley, who just finished his third year of studies as a seminarian at the North American College in Rome will be ordained to the transitional diaconate on October 1, 2026 at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. Bishop Robert Barron will be the ordaining bishop for Thomas and his classmates. We have about fourteen spots left in the group that I will be leading, which will include Rome and the Shrines of Italy. It's going to be a great trip. Fr. Vincent Richardson will be joining the trip, fittingly, as another son of the parish, to be there for the ordination and the pilgrimage. The trip is going to be wonderful. ***Totus Tuus* (Totally Yours)**

This week, we'll have the *Totus Tuus* team running programs Monday through Friday 9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. for students going into 1st - 6th grades during the day, and evening programs from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. Sunday through Thursday for middle and high school students (7th - 12th grades). Come to Mercy Hall for the program start. The day program is full at this time. The evening program for middle and high school students is open to anyone, not just members of the parish. Feel free to invite others to participate.

**What does *Totus Tuus* mean?**

It stems from St. Louis de Montfort's *True Devotion to Mary*. In that book, St. Louis writes of Mary: "*Totus tuus ego sum et omnia mea tua sunt...* I am totally yours and all that I have is yours." With these words, St. Louis not only expresses his love for Mary but his desire to belong completely to God like her and with her. Louis believed that this Marian spirituality of "*Totus tuus...totally yours*" is "the most perfect of all devotions" because "it conforms, unites and consecrates us most perfectly to Jesus Christ" (St. Louis de Montfort, *True Devotion to Mary*). Pope St. John Paul II took *Totus Tuus* as his episcopal motto and he lived it out faithfully.

**From the *Totus Tuus* website:**

*Totus Tuus* is a summer Catholic youth program dedicated to sharing the Gospel and promoting the Catholic Faith through evangelization, catechesis, Christian witness, and Eucharistic worship. Our week-long Parish Summer Catechetical Program assists parents and parishes in the evangelizing and catechizing of their youth by supplementing the work they are currently doing.

The methodology, structure, content, and enthusiasm of *Totus Tuus* are concerned not only with teaching the Faith, but also igniting the hearts of the team members and the young people they encounter. The result has been the formation of young adults who continue to dedicate themselves to the Church's mission of evangelization along with many vocations to the priesthood and religious life.

**What's the *Totus Tuus* Evening Program?**

The evenings include fellowship, growth in faith, discussion groups, and games. The middle school and high school sessions are from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. Sunday through Thursday. There will be some time set aside for prayer, reconciliation, and adoration. *Totus Tuus* team members will invite students to join them at the end of Mass this weekend. Students from prior years report that they were glad they participated in the evening program. Please keep the day and evening programs and the missionaries in your prayers. Thanks!
