Director of Parish Operations

About a month ago, we posted a job description and asked for applications for the part time Director of Parish Operations position to fill the post that Sara DeWitt had held for about ten years. Through prayer and discernment, Cristin Luea has accepted the position at the parish. She will continue to be involved with various aspects of the school program, but will not be teaching part-time in 5th Grade. Jacob interviewed for that position, and has offered it to Mary Glomski. The memo that went out to the school about this transition is as follows:

Though the guidance of the Holy Spirit, with much prayer and discussion, Mrs. Cristin Luea will be taking the position of Director of Parish Operations, beginning in mid-August. She will be overseeing the programs of the parish, making sure they are well-planned, implemented, and evaluated so we can be effective in serving our parish and building the Kingdom of God. You’ll continue to see her at school as she oversees Mrs. Abbie Stoll in the Library and spearheads March is Reading Month, the Bookfair, and the Children’s Market.

Mrs. Mary Glomski will be our new full-time 5th grade teacher. She is mother of John (7th), Kateri (3rd) and Matthias (1st) and has been a teacher for 13 years. She has a special passion for history and literature. In her spare time, she is a sheep farmer, gardener, and “chicken tender” with her husband Evan. Her joy, liveliness and experience will be a huge blessing to our school.

We are still in the midst of the interview process for our first grade teacher, continuing to meet with and evaluate candidates, making sure we have the best one for our students.

I’m very grateful for Cristin’s willingness to make this change. Please pray for her, for the team at the parish as we anticipate this change, as well as the school, as they anticipate a change in 5th grade and also continue to search for a First Grade teacher. Come, Holy Spirit!

One More Time: Join Us for Thomas’s Ordination

Thomas Crowley just finished his third year of studies as a seminarian at the North American College in Rome and will be ordained to the transitional diaconate on October 1, 2026 at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. Bishop Robert Barron will be the ordaining bishop for Thomas and his classmates.

We have about fourteen spots left in the group that I will be leading, which will include Rome and the Shrines of Italy. It’s going to be a great trip. Fr. Vincent Richardson will be joining the trip, fittingly, as another son of the parish, to be there for the ordination and the pilgrimage. The trip is going to be wonderful. We will not have a meeting as a group until the middle of August, but I am planning to begin group emails to the pilgrimage group later this month. I’d love to have you join us for this great trip.

America 250

This coming Saturday, July 4, 2026, we will celebrate 250 years of Independence. It is a fitting thing to celebrate, because, though imperfect, the US Constitution was (and continues to be) informed by truths that are indispensable to any truly free and just nation.
