As you know, I have celebrated the *Novus Ordo* Latin (with English Propers) Mass since the promulgation of *Traditionis Custodes* on the second Sunday of the month at the 11:00 a.m. Mass. After talking with David Stattelman, it seemed prudent for us to put that on hold until the choir is back. They help support our celebration and singing of the Latin Mass. All of that to say, despite the note in last week's bulletin to the contrary, this coming Sunday's 11:00 a.m. Mass will be in English, as will the 11:00 a.m. Mass on August 9th. Thank you for understanding.

C.S. Lewis on Becoming Our True Selves

Last Sunday, I read from the very end of Lewis's *Mere Christianity*. It seemed fitting in light of the last few Sunday's Gospels. I share it here for your reference and prayerful meditation. Let's be among those who are living fully in Christ and so becoming our true selves in Him. Come, Holy Spirit!

It is when I turn to Christ, when I give myself up to His Personality, that I first begin to have a real personality of my own.

. . . . Until you have given up your self to Him you will not have a real self. Sameness is to be found most among the most 'natural' men, not among those who surrender to Christ. How monotonously alike all the great tyrants and conquerors have been: how gloriously different are the saints.

But there must be a real giving up of the self. You must throw it away 'blindly' so to speak. Christ will indeed give you a real personality: but you must not go to Him for the sake of that. As long as your own personality is what you are bothering about you are not going to Him at all. The very first step is to try to forget about the self altogether. Your real, new self (which is Christ's and also yours, and yours just because it is His) will not come as long as you are looking for it. It will come

when you are looking for Him. Does that sound strange? The same principle holds, you know, for more everyday matters. Even in social life, you will never make a good impression on other people until you stop thinking about what sort of impression you are making. Even in literature and art, no man who bothers about originality will ever be original: whereas if you simply try to tell the truth (without caring twopence how often it has been told before) you will, nine times out of ten, become original without ever having noticed it. The principle runs through all life from top to bottom. Give up yourself, and you will find your real self. Lose your life and you will save it. Submit to death, death of your ambitions and favourite wishes every day and death of your whole body in the end: submit with every fibre of your being, and you will find eternal life. Keep back nothing. Nothing that you have not given away will be really yours. Nothing in you that has not died will ever be raised from the dead. Look for yourself, and you will find in the long run only hatred, loneliness, despair, rage, ruin, and decay. But look for Christ and you will find Him, and with Him everything else thrown in.

I'll be headed north this coming Thursday for a week in God's Country. I'll be headed to Copper Harbor again. Please pray for me as I travel and seek some rest and renewal. Be assured of my prayers for you. All of the Masses and confession times during my absence are covered. I'm hoping to be able to celebrate Masses again at Our Lady of the Pines in Copper Harbor. I hope and pray that all of you will also (at some point) get some time away for rest and renewal, as well. God bless you all.
