New Saint Statues

Resurrection School has recently added five statues of saints to the outside of the middle school/gym building. The building was originally constructed in 1939 and served as Resurrection High School. The building has always had five niches designed for saints to be placed, and this opportunity to beautify our campus was noticed through the keen eyes of a few staff members.

The selection process was not easy for us. There are many wonderful saints, and they are all praying for us. However, our staff chose five wonderful saint statues within the neoclassical style already employed in the outdoor crucifix in front of the gym and the grotto in front of the convent. Those five saints are St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, St. Patrick, St. Augustine, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. John Neumann. St. Elizabeth Ann Seton who is known for starting the first Catholic girl's school in the US and the first American congregation of religious sisters. She was a dedicated educator, but she was also a wife, a mother, a widow,

and a convert . . . We chose to place St. Elizabeth Ann Seton's statue in the niche nearest to the convent where the Dominican Sisters of Mary, Mother of the Eucharist live . . . [W]e wanted to honor St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, as we also honor the gift of many religious sisters who have taught countless children during the 100-year history of Resurrection School.

St. Patrick was an easy choice for us. We are the Resurrection Shamrocks, which our founding pastor, Monsignor Gabriels, chose based on his Irish heritage, and we have proudly worn this symbol of the Holy Trinity ever since. So, it was only fitting that St. Patrick would stand in the niche directly above the door where the students come into the building every morning.

St. Augustine stands in the northwest niche between the school and the church. He will be the main statue that parishioners see as they walk into Mass each day, and we hope they are reminded of how, like St. Augustine, God never gives up on us, no matter how far we stray from the path. St. Augustine's own Confessions bear witness to how far he wandered from God's Truth and Goodness, the power of a mother's prayer, and how God's divine love is constantly drawing us into a deeper conversion of heart. St. Thomas Aquinas is the other famous theologian and Doctor of the Church featured in the niche between the school and the church, just off Michigan Ave. He is probably the most brilliant mind of the last millennium. His writings are some of the richest and complex spiritual works in Church history, which is demonstrated by how St. Thomas Aquinas would dictate to four different scribes writing in four different sections of the Summa Theologica at the same time.

Last but not least, St. John Neumann stands in the niche facing Michigan Ave. He was missionary priest to the Native Americans in New York and later the Bishop of Philadelphia. During the 8 years that he served as Bishop, 100 Catholic schools were built in his diocese. This was a time when Protestant apologetics were being taught in public schools in order to convert Catholic children away from the Church. St. John Neumann famously told his priests to build the school before you build the church. That is exactly what Msgr. Gabriels did when he founded our parish in the 1920s. The church was the last of the buildings built on the campus during his tenure as pastor. May he rest in peace!
