Blessings and peace!! While I wasn't expecting quite so much snow this week, it sure is beautiful. I hope everyone was able to enjoy the snow day after all the shoveling!

Here's some items to note this week:

- **Re-Enrollment Is Open:** All the forms can be accessed through the FACTS Family Portal. Enrollment will be open to the public beginning February 2nd. The tuition assistance application is also open for the Archdiocese. More information is below. Please let us know if you have any questions!
- **2nd Quarter Report Cards Are Accessible in FACTS:** For our 4-8th grade families, report cards now reflect a semester grade in addition to quarters. Since we changed the grading scale to model high schools, we also tweaked the report card to average the quarters in a semester grade. This is also similar to the high school grading system. We want students to start getting used to high school expectations to ease their transition in a few years! Those

semester grades will be used to configure our honor roll which is for 5th - 8th graders with all A's on semester grades and high conduct marks of C or U.


