

School Sources of Income


Tuition: monies collected from families largely covers the cost of staff salaries and benefits.

Parish Subsidy: the parish helps with operational costs through the weekly Sunday collection. In Parish Families have a reduced tuition because they are contributing members of the parish, attend Mass on Sundays and give of time, talent and/or treasure.

Fundraising: our Fall Bash, Fun Run and Scholarship Appeal are our main community fundraisers of the year. Proceeds largely support facilities, technology, or curriculum updates. Any additional monies raised go towards scholarships.

Grants: we apply every year for different State and Federal monies which support particular programming such as professional development or new security measures.

• The Gap reflects the amount per student not covered by tuition received but still needed to cover educational costs.

Discounts and Scholarships for 2024 - 2025

- OLGC awards a 50% discount to students of all staff members
- Tuition Assistance Program (Vollbrecht Scholarship) awarded \$103,653
- Multi-Family Discounts awarded
 - Per Family of 2.....\$758.11
 - Per Family of 3.....\$2,560.24
 - Per Family of 3+.....\$2,560.24 + full tuition for every student above 3
