Steven Bell, CSP (Paulist priest) will preach at all weekend masses Feb. 23-24. On February 24-26 please join Fr. Steve in the church at 7 p.m. for three powerful and engaging evenings focused on the power of healing, reconciliation, prayer and mercy in our lives.

Ordained in 2008, Fr. Steve served in the Diocese of Austin as the Associate Pastor of St. Austin then became Associate Director of Busted Halo, a radio show of the Paulist Fathers media ministry. Following his Busted Halo assignment, Fr. Steve was a campus minister at the St. Thomas More Newman Center at the Ohio State University in Columbus, OH. He also gives missions, retreats, revivals, and workshops all over the country.

Parish Missions are a way for the whole parish to pause a bit in daily life and focus some additional precious time on the Lord and His action in our life. You hear a lot from the priests about holiness in their daily or weekly homilies. Preaching during a Mission gives some added insights into our call to holiness. I am confident Fr. Steve will inspire you in many ways through his preaching and witnessing to the faith.

Our mission is situated before Lent starts. We would have liked it during Lent but Fr. Bell was already booked a year ago so this is the next best time for us without having to wait another year. I am confident that his message will even more so prepare us for a very fruitful Lent (which begins on Ash Wednesday, March 6).

Parish Mission time is a Grace filled time for the parish. A time of renewal. A mini retreat. A shot in the arm. All possible if people are open to the Holy Spirit working through the preacher!



Please set aside the dates and time now in your calendars and join in the Mission. Invite neighbors, family or friends. This is one of those opportunities, or "soft entry points", that can engage or re-engage someone with the church and, most importantly, Jesus.

Our focal point was a cross laid on the steps of the altar and surrounded by candles. After a scripture


passage and reflection, led by My. Kerry Vlahantones, students were invited to write a short prayer, personal intention or request and then place it in the basket at the foot of the altar.

Being a Lector these last few years has heightened my interest in Sacred Scripture. I think that is because the preparation involves not just learning the words but understanding the message prior to proclaiming the Word of God at Mass.

We know from the Catechism of the Catholic Church that "God is the author of Sacred Scripture...God inspired the human authors of the sacred books." We also know that the Holy Spirit is our in-

terpreter: "Sacred Scripture must be read and interpreted in light of the same Spirit by whom it was written."

Through scripture, we learn a lot about God. The

more we read, the more we learn about Him – His love for us, His mercy, and His Son who was sent to teach us how to live and who is our salvation.

At Mass, listening attentively to His Word and reflecting upon it help us prepare to receive Christ in the Sacrament of the Eucharist.

More than being simply a source of information, His Word is an avenue of God speaking to us personally. This is only effective if we take the time to think about how it can and should affect our life, that is our encounter with Christ and

with others.

Christ wants us to live

like He did ...

It could be following up on those ideas that simply pop up in our mind, whether they be about our spiritual life or reaching out to others.

The ideas may not always come that easily. And the follow-up can be challenging. But that shouldn't stop us.

Christ wants us to live like He did in making lives better. Love, service, caring,

healing, justice, mercy, salvation. These He spoke about and demonstrated while on earth. And this is what He wants us to share.

That is why one of the "going forth" verses we sing at the end of Mass is:

"Take the Word to our neighborhoods and streets shine the light of Christ for all to see May we all set out to live in peace and harmony.

They will see and sing..."

Young 5's is a busy classroom of learning and fun. We participate in preschool activities that will get us ready for Kindergarten. We have been learning the letters and

sounds of the alphabet in order to start the reading process. Last week, we worked on the letter "Pp". We practiced the letter by saying it, by writing it, and by identifying it in words. We acted out the story The Three Pigs and played puppet theatre. We snacked on peanut butter, pretzels, and popcorn.

In Math, we are learning the numbers and patterning concepts necessary for counting, adding and subtracting. We have been learning the

numbers 0-10 and how to touch each item as we count for 1 to 1 correspondence. We work on small motor skills for writing by molding play dough, stringing beads and singing finger play songs. We work on our large motor skills too by playing in the gym and on the playground. Some other things we have been accomplishing this school year

include becoming more social, working with others and learning how to be good friends.

On Friday of Catholic Schools week, we were able to bring in a Special Person. We took them to Mass and then for a snack and activities in our classroom.

It is wonderful to be able to share our Catholic Faith

with others at school and we are happy to learn about Jesus and his love.


