MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

** For those who missed the announcement last weekend: Archbishop Vigneron has appointed Fr. Marko as (administrator) Pastor of St. Moses the Black parish in Detroit effective July 1, 2019. A few years ago when St. Gregory the Great in Detroit, St. Benedict in Highland Park and Madonna Parish in Detroit merged into one, the name of the new parish became St. Moses the



Black. [St. Moses the Black was an ascetic monk and priest in Egypt in the fourth century, a notable Desert Father.] The site of the parish is the former Madonna Church at the Focus: Hope complex. The parish has about 450 families. He will continue to live at Holy Rosary Parish in community with the other priests who form the community of the Detroit Oratory of St. Philip Neri.

It was two years ago that Fr. Marko began his present assignment as the Associate Pastor of Holy Rosary Parish. Due to the very limited liturgical and sacramental activity at Holy Rosary, he was assigned to Star of the Sea as the "weekend associate." I know some of you thought he lived here or had an office here but his parish assignment limited his involvement with Star of the Sea to providing sacramental help on weekends and other
