In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

We thank you for the joys and sorrows of her life, the giving and sharing, and, especially for your love that has formed us in your image.


Listen to our prayers and bless the mother who has nurtured and sustained us. Give us patience in abundance and let her find joy and satisfaction in all her work.

Today we celebrate Mother's Day. We have been celebrating Mother's Day in the U.S. annually on the second Sunday in May since 1914.

It was Ann Jarvis of West Virginia who pushed for a national day to honor mothers. In 1914, President Woodrow Wilson made it a national holiday.

By the 1920s Ann Jarvis became so fed up with how commercial the holiday had become that she actually filed a lawsuit to stop one Mother's Day event from taking place!

Not celebrating Mother's Day is a little extreme. Remembering our mothers who are still with us and those who have gone to their eternal reward is still important. It's how we choose to remember that we should rethink.

The day doesn't have to involve elaborate gifts or celebrations. For me, the hugs, kisses and "I love yours" from my kids and grandkids are more precious to me than gold. And remembering my Mom and her great meals and her sayings and quotes brings her to life for me.

Getting back to basics should be the theme of the day.

- Call your mom just to say "I love you," even if you talk to her or see her regularly.
- If your mom has passed away, honor her by taking flowers to her grave, fixing one of her favorite recipes or telling a favorite story about her.
- Remember godmothers and those who are like a mother to you.
- Honor our "spiritual" mothers.
- Give the gift of time.
- Instead of a gift, write down all the things you love about your mom or all the lessons that your mom has taught you and give it to her.
- Remember with a smile all the "momisms"—"Look at me when I'm talking to you."; "Don't you roll your eyes at me!"; "If so and so jumped off a cliff, would you jump too?"; "If you can't say something nice, don't say anything at all." Etc., etc, etc.
- It's great having a day devoted to recognizing all that moms do but remember that you don't have to save up your "thank yous" and "I love yous" for Mother's Day.

Why? Because I SAID SO, that's why!?!
