No one has the right to another person's certificate, except: the parent/guardian of a minor child. (Archdiocese of Detroit)

### ANOINTING OF THE SICK/ MINISTRY TO THE SICK

The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

### **MARRIAGE**

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

### **PARISH REGISTRATION**

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours. Others, please notify the Parish Office of address changes. Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.



Throughout the year, but more so during the Spring, we get numerous requests to verify that a person "is in good standing." This is usually because someone has been requested to be a sponsor or God parent for the Sacrament of Confirmation or Baptism. Often, it is also requested to give a person permission to get married in different parish church. Usually, it is not a problem. We check our records to see if the individual is registered on their own and get some indication of their regular Sunday Mass participation. Unfortunately, there are often some

difficulties for me to verify if a person is in good standing within the parish. Why are people asked to register in a parish?

In the United States, it is almost without exception that individuals or families are asked to "register" in a parish. First, it helps the pastor of the flock, in his obligation to support the needs and mission of the community, to have the names and addresses of those who are committing to being a member of the parish community. Throughout the year, parishioners receive mail or notifications, electronically or otherwise, to keep them informed of the spiritual, formation and social opportunities available in the community. This is an important part of the development and growth of the community. Second, it gives insight to the pastor about the makeup of the parish community, its needs and corresponding pastoral care. Third, the number of parishioners may also determine if extra pastoral-priest assistance is needed due to the number of registered households.

On the other hand, it gives the individual or family registering a sense of belonging to a community, a sign or commitment to practice the faith, and opportunities in their obligation to support the needs and mission of the parish community. This can be accomplished in many ways through the sharing of time, talent, and treasure. What is important is the active participation in the life of the parish, especially through participation in the Sunday Eucharist.

Does the fact that a person was baptized here, or made other sacraments here many years ago, and now lives out of the area a parishioner today? No. Does the fact a person went to school here, or participated in religious education, many years ago make them a parishioner today? No. Does a person who was registered as a child with her/his parents years ago still make them a parishioner today. No. Generally, when a person becomes 18, or 21, or most definitely moves out of the parental household, that person should register in a parish just as they register on their own for a driver's license, insurance, renting an apartment, responsible for their adult living expenses, etc. Without a registration, or a personal awareness and relationship with the pastor, it is very difficult, in all honesty and truth, to verify an individual as an active parishioner, especially if they have not been around for several years. (How do you know if you are still registered in a parish? If you have not been receiving any letters or information electronically or through the US mail, you are more most likely no longer registered!) Registration makes it so much easier when someone wants to marry, be a Godparent or sponsor, have their baby baptized and receive the other sacrament of the Church.

Those of you who are parents might gently encourage older independent children to register in a parish, one where they experience a community, and Sunday Mass, that will be an essential element in their faith and the practice of their Catholic faith. (This is especially the case if there is a probable marriage, baptism, possibility of being a Godparent, etc, in the near future.)

- \*\* This weekend (Saturday, May 15) two men have been ordained as priests for the Archdiocese of Detroit and another one will be ordained this coming Saturday, May 22. Thanks be to God! Please continue to pray for an increase in vocations to the ordained and vowed ministries.
- \*\* Next weekend is **Pentecost.** "Traditionally" we have asked people to **wear red to Mass** and, if you can, bring a **red geranium** (or two or six) to beautify our campus throughout the summer!!
- \*\*For those who have given to CSA before, you should have received your mailing. Please use the envelope that was included in the packet, to mail your Gift/Pledge to the Archdiocese of Detroit processing center in Minnesota.


