Sometimes it is difficult to understand some of the concepts or mysteries that we celebrate in the Church. Pentecost and the power of the Holy Spirit can be one of those mysteries. Maybe this little "word picture" can be of assistance.

#### Prayer to the Spirit Paraclete



It is a clear reminder that our Blessed Mother is both Mother of Christ and Mother of the Church. This is not a new title for Mary. Blessed Pope Paul VI gave this title to her in a1964. St. John Paul II had a mosaic of Our Lady commissioned to overlook St. Peter's square after he attributed his life being saved by Our Blessed Mother when shot by an assassin on May 13, 1981. The title under the mosaic reads, Mother of the Church. Let's be specially mindful of the role of our Blessed Mother in our life on Monday. Yes, she has many titles but one that is over all. Mother of the Church!
