Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.



Through the ages, people have always experienced anxiety personally, at work, in relationships, etc. The need for peace is universal.

We are always looking for ways to relieve that anxiety and feel inner peace. Many are turning toward mindfulness, meditations, yoga, etc. which all have their benefits.

Catholics have a rich tradition which offers the best way to create and maintain inner peace—encountering Christ in prayer.

We know lots of vocal prayers, but mental prayer is different. It's a spontaneous conversation with God.

It's about encountering Jesus and building a personal relationship with Him.
