

The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

Today, Sunday, October 7, is traditionally the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. As you know the Rosary is an excellent prayer for an individual, a family, or a group of people. There is a great sense of unity for those who pray the Rosary. St. John Paul II said in his 2002 apostolic letter on the Rosary said: *As a prayer for peace, the Rosary is also, and always has been, a prayer of and for the family. At one time this prayer was particularly dear to Christian families, and it certainly brought them closer together. It is important not to lose this precious inheritance. We need to return to the practice of family prayer and prayer for families, continuing to use the Rosary....The family that prays together stays together. The Holy Rosary, by age-old tradition, has shown itself particularly effective as a prayer which brings the family together. Individual family members, in turning their eyes towards Jesus, also regain the ability to look one another in the eye, to communicate, to show solidarity, to forgive one another and to see their covenant of love renewed in the Spirit of God. (ROSARIUM VIRGINIS MARIAE)*

This program is intended for children aged 12 months to 3 years. This will be a PILOT program for the months of October through December -be sure to take advantage of this opportunity so that we can have a good base to assess the level of interest of continuing to offer it throughout the year.

Our Little Sailors Childcare is a cheerful, safe and welcoming environment for our youngest parishioners and is staffed by a paid Childcare Coordinator as well as volunteer aides. Our Childcare Room is located in **Room 29 in the School with entry from The Pointe.**

All parents will be required to complete a Child Information Form the first time you bring your child to us. Each week, parents must sign in/sign out their child and will be required to show proof of identity at pick up. *Your child's safety is our first priority!* You will be provided with our Little Sailors Child Care Guidelines when you drop off your child the first time.

There is somewhat of a revival of praying the Rosary that is going on. And there are visible signs that this is happening.

A number of new books and devotional booklets have been written in recent years on the Rosary and there seem to be more prayer groups in existence.

This past April, thousands gathered in groups around the British coast to pray the Rosary for "faith, life, and peace".

Last October 7th, the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, our own Rosary Garden was dedicated followed by a large group praying the Rosary.

This year during the summer months, the Rosary has been prayed there each Thursday evening and will be prayed Sunday, October 7.

A decline in the usage of this beautiful devotion to Our Lady occurred somewhere in the middle of the twentieth century. Some have thought it was one of the outcomes of Vatican II. That is just not true.

Church documents and papal writings

since then have emphasized the role of Mary in the Church and encouraged Marian devotions, particularly the beauty and depth of praying the Rosary.

Some have raised objections to the Rosary, calling it rote prayer, but that doesn't happen if one pays attention to the words. Just think of the beautiful prayers that we say.

The Hail Mary is largely taken from Bible verses. Saying the Our Father is the way Jesus taught us to pray. The Apostles Creed recounts what we believe. The Glory Be gives praise and honor to the three persons of the Blessed Trinity.

Pope Benedict XVI wrote that "the Rosary is experiencing a new Springtime...The Rosary, when it is prayed in an authentic way, not mechanical and superficial but profoundly, it brings, in fact, peace and reconciliation. It contains within itself the healing power of the Most Holy Name of Jesus, invoked with faith and love at the center of each Hail Mary."
