

It has been a year that we have been living with our parish mission statement: *With Mary, we bring people to Christ to live the love of God.*

I hope you know our mission statement. It is not too long or complex. "To live the love of God" implies living in the love, God graciously bestows upon us. When we acknowledge that fact, we then have a natural inclination to respond out of the love we receive from God. To live the love of God is like any other love! When we are in love there is a joyfulness that exudes from us, we want others to know the love and goodness in our life. We share the generosity that is given to us. When we share with others, the happiness deep within us, we are then "witnessing," as the Church would call it. So you see, all of this is not too complex! It is the same thing we experience in our daily life. For some reason, when people think of it in "Church" terms they get a little frightened! Don't be frightened. Mary, our Star of the Sea, will help to bring us and other people to live in and with the love of God in all aspects of their life! What is important is that we ask for Mary's help and know that she accompanies us.

As Mary accompanies us along our journey, across the "seas" of life, we likewise then have to accompany others. Discipleship is always outward looking. As Mary, Jesus, God, the Holy Spirit, and the Saints accompany us, we join with others.

Today you find in this paper the many ways that we are called to accompany others along the way in this parish. You see so many opportunities! They are opportunities to come to know others. They are opportunities to address the "needs" of people inside the parish and outside the parish. One example would be in terms of hospitality, i.e., one area that people like to receive, but in order for people to receive it there needs to be people to give it!! (I hope that makes sense!) Another example of the "needs" are the areas that help to keep things "running" smoothly, e.g., sacristans, ushers, etc. Other opportunities seem to enhance our parish life, e.g., musical abilities, continuation of parish events like **Fallfest**, **The Taste**, the Golf Outing and Auction. The bottom line is our parish will only be stronger, more vibrant, appealing, and known for living the Love of God to the extent that everyone shares in the task of making the parish shine in so many ways!

In the Archbishop's letter, *Unleash the Gospel*, he mentions that as we move from maintenance



mode to mission mode there can be no bystanders. How true! Everyone's participation is essential and everyone can participate. While 80% percent is capable to help in the "physical" needs and work of the parish community, the other 20% can certainly offer their prayers and sacrifices for the good of the parish and for those doing the "other work." So there are no bystanders in our mission!! Everyone can be engaged through prayer and/or physical activity for the good of the parish and spreading the love of God!

Next weekend is "engagement weekend." Everyone has something to share and give to the community through time, talent and treasure. After Masses next weekend you can find information about the ministries and opportunities in The Pointe. If specific volunteerism is not possible, a prayer commitment is a valued gift to be engaged!

** Men of the parish: retreat time is coming up. Think and pray about it. A few days away from the norm to relax, reflect, listen to God and the Holy Spirit, and return in a better way!

** Last Sunday Matthew Jakubisin gave a fantastic recital on music that reflects Mary, Our Lady Star of the Sea in the past few centuries. What a treat for the ears and the soul it was. I agree with others that Matthew is one of the best church organists in the whole area!

This will be a **PILOT program** for the months of October through December. *IF YOU THINK YOU'D LIKE TO HAVE THIS AVAILABLE FOR YOUR FAMILY SO THAT YOU CAN REALLY PARTICIPATE IN MASS*, be sure to take advantage of this opportunity so that we can have a good base to assess the level of interest of continuing to offer it throughout the year.

Our Little Sailors Childcare is a cheerful, safe and welcoming environment for our youngest parishioners and is staffed by a paid Childcare Coordinator as well as volunteer aides. Our Childcare Room is located in **Room 29 in the School with entry from The Pointe.**

All parents will be required to complete a Child Information Form the first time you bring your child to us. Each week, parents must sign in/sign out their child and will be required to show proof of identity at pick up. *Your child's safety is our first priority!* You will be provided with our Little Sailors Child Care Guidelines when you drop off your child the first time.

UNLEASH THE GOSPEL

Last week's article talked about the beauty and richness of the individual prayers of the Rosary and trying to say them with attention, not mechanically or superficially.

Another dimension of praying the Rosary relates to its mysteries. Meditating on the mysteries is a simple way to do meditative prayer.

Pope Benedict XVI wrote that, in saying the Rosary, "Christ is put at the center of our life, of our time, of our city, through the contemplation and meditation of his holy mysteries of joy, light, sorrow and glory."

The twenty mysteries are events in the lives of Jesus and His Mother. In meditating on them, we discover the richness of the Rosary. We can think about what each mystery is about, the effect it had, and what it inspires us to do.

St. John Paul II urged the faithful to "Rediscover the Rosary in the light of Scripture, in harmony with the Liturgy, and in the context of your daily lives."

A number of thought starters for meditation on the mysteries are available in online or booklet form. They assist us by providing descriptions of the mysteries for reflection, along with their meaning for us as followers of Christ.

The Fruits of the Mysteries are sometimes included with the descriptions of the mysteries. The Fruits are virtues associated with each of the mysteries that we should emulate. For example, for the Visitation, the Fruit of the Mystery is "Love of Neighbor" and for The Wedding Feast at Cana, it is "To Jesus through Mary".

The Rosary isn't just for older people or the very holy as some may want to believe. It is for everyone, especially families. Praying together makes the family stronger and more unified. There's a saying that "The family that prays together stays together".

Young people are our future; they are the future of the Church. Papal documents and "Unleash the Gospel", our archdiocesan charter for the future, encourage prayer within families.
