MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours. Others, please notify the Parish Office of address changes. Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.

people to Star, to enjoy a great evening and then hopefully be a lucky winner at the Catch A Lucky Star raffle. But we had to do something different.







FORMING OUR FAITH

"That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked at and our hands have touched—this we proclaim concerning the Word of life. "— 1 John 1:1

Good and Bad Habits in the Church

In the 2017 Pastoral Letter, "Unleash the Gospel," Archbishop Allen Vigneron points out "Good and Bad Habits" of Church life, which describe things that should change in parish life as well as the great things the Church can become! We will go through one per week. Let's ask Our Lord for a change of heart, to drop any bad habits and replace them with what He would have us be!

Bad — Status-Quo Mentality

Pope Francis has implored the Church: "Be bold and creative!" Parishes and the Church as a whole can get caught up in a "Status-Quo Mentality," which simply says, "We have always done it this way...why change? We are 'good enough." But Our Lord doesn't want us doing things simply because we feel like "This is the way it's always been." Stuck in that mentality, we never grow. We can never be bold and creative as the Holv Father asks us to be. We have to continue to spread the Good News of what Jesus has done for us, and we have to do it in an ever-changing age. This is going to require getting out of our comfort zones...but that is okay! Because of last week's Good Habit, "Confidence in God," we can be sure that Our Lord will guide us through these different times, just as He walked with Peter on the water.

Faith Formation is a home-study process this year, but that has not stopped our Confirmation candidates from working to complete Mercy Experiences in preparation for the Sacrament!


