Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

When we open our heart and our mind, it is easier to prepare. It seems we are always preparing for something as we prepare for school, our jobs or ministries, our vacations, moving into a new home, etc. As we anticipate Christmas, there is a lot of preparations going on. You prepare for gift giving, for decorating the inside and outside of the house, for family gatherings, etc.

Advent is the time to *prepare* for Christmas. We see the days get shorter and the darkness of the night starts sooner. With Christmas, and the Light of Christ, the days get longer and brighter – just as the presence of Christ sheds light in our life. Even as we might put up the tree and decorations around the house, and as we light up the outside of our homes, let us be mindful of how we are preparing for the Christmas season that *begins*, not ends, on Dec. 25.

Our Advent focus this year is “Prepare Him room.” As you prepare space or a room in your house for an upcoming guest, what do you do? You probably think “what can I do to make this person feel welcome?” You clean, maybe purge some items, tidy up the area, etc. Sometimes preparing for a guest is very helpful to us because it gives us the opportunity for renewal. Advent is a time for a new beginning, another renewal, another chance to be intimately connected with Jesus. Feel like you have been missing something? Let Jesus enter and find the best home available! If you have been lax about participating in Sunday Mass, this is a perfect time to change that habit! It will be good for the soul!

As you prepare your soul, your heart, your home this Advent, pause from the rush throughout the day and spend time being with God. See in the “things” of the season the many expressions of God’s majesty and love. Experience the Sacraments and let the Grace of God flow through you!

MASS INTENTIONS

What does it mean to have a Mass "offered" for someone?

An individual may ask a priest to offer a Mass for several reasons: for example, in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person (such as on a birthday), or, as is most common, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died.

It is worth noting, however, that the offering of the Mass for that intention does not depend on it being publicly voiced but on it being specified in the priest's personal prayers. Similarly, if a priest announces that "I am offering this Mass for [such and such an] intention" he does not thereby require the rest of the congregation to pray for that intention.
