

Tomorrow, Sept.27, is the traditional feast day of Our Lady Star of the Sea. *St. Bernard of Clairvaux* is one who have written about Our Lady under this title.

Depend upon the star, call upon Mary Let us say a few words on this name, Stella Maris, which means star of the sea, and which is appropriately accorded to the Virgin Mother. Fittingly is she compared to the stars, since just as a star gives light without burning itself out, so the virgin gave birth to her son without stain to herself. As a star's light does

not lessen its own brightness so neither does the Son lessen the Virgin's wholeness. She is therefore that noble star rising from Jacob which casts light over the whole world; whose splendor shines to the heavens and reaches down into the deep; which crosses the earth, warming spirits rather than bodies; fostering goodness and purging sins.

And so I say that she is that bright and distinguished star to be raised above this vast ocean, sparkling with merit, shining with character. Whoever you may be, grasp that, as this age runs its course, you are tossed on the waves by gales and storms more than you walk upon dry land; do not turn your eyes from the beam of this star if you do not wish to be swamped by the storm! If the winds of temptation engulf you, if you are running onto the rocks of adversity, depend upon the star, call upon Mary. If you are thrown about on the waves of pride or ambition, speaking ill of others or jealousy, depend upon the star, call upon Mary. If anger or greed or the cares of the flesh batter your soul's boat, depend upon Mary. If you are unsettled by the hideousness of your sins, troubled by a bad conscience, terrified by the horror of the final judgment; if you are beginning to be dragged down into the pit of sadness, into the abyss of despair, reflect upon Mary. In danger; in distress, in doubt, reflect upon Mary, call upon Mary. Let her not leave your lips, let her not leave your heart and do not abandon your dealings with her if you wish to gain the object of your prayer.

Following her, you will not stray; praying to her, you will not despair; reflecting upon her, you will not go wrong. With her taking your hand, you will not fall down; with her protecting you, you will not fear; with her leading you, you will not grow weary; with her favor, you will accomplish; and thus you will learn for yourself how truly it is said: And the Virgin's name was Mary.

But now, having pause for a moment, let us all who are passing through this life gaze upon the brightness of such a light. For in the words of the Apostle, It is good for us to be here, and it is pleasing to contemplate in silence what which many words fail to explain. In the meantime, while contemplating devotedly the shining star, the debate will be rekindled in what follows.

Especially in these troubled and uncertain times, we turn to *Our Lady Star of the Sea* to bring calm to our life as She brings us closer to Christ!

"The Lord upholds my life, the Lord upholds my life, the Lord upholds my life..."

This was the antiphon (refrain) to our Psalm last Sunday. In the middle of the night on Tuesday I woke up from my sleep, and this antiphon was playing over and over in my head. Has this happened to you, hearing a

musical phrase in one's head? I'm sure when I woke and heard this phrase sounding in my head it was a gift from God, reminding me of this very basic truth. Singing it over and over again this past weekend when we sang the Psalm certainly did what doing so is meant to do, in that it became lodged in my subconscious, to reecho during the course of the week when one needs a word of assurance. Such is the gift of and wisdom behind singing Psalm antiphons in the Mass and in the Daily Office; they become seeds in our souls, only to sprout and grow and bear fruit.

Speaking of the Psalms and singing, at the first rehearsal of the Star Choir on September 15 we sang a hymn which touches on the pride of place of the Psalms in worship and encapsulates so much about singing and music. We sang this hymn at the beginning of the rehearsal as a way to focus everyone present on why we were there, and then again at the end of the rehearsal when we prayed and sang Night Prayer (Compline). It was written in 1966 by Albert Bayly, and English pastor, at the request of Dr Lee Hastings Bristol Jr, president of Westminster Choir College (my alma mater!) for the senior class, and while it isn't in either of our hymnbooks, it has become a stable in many hymns in recent years.

The hymn covers a lot of ground, including the Psalms, drawing plentifully from Scripture, beginning with the creation narrative in Job 38: 6-7, continuing with allusions to Temple worship as described in II Chronicles 29: 27-30, Psalm 81: 1-13, and Psalm 150. With the synagogue pattern of worship translated into the Christian pattern, the hymn echoes Ephesians 5: 19 and Colossians 3: 16, and then concludes with a pledge of dedication to God's service that draws on Isaiah 6: 6-7. What a comprehensive expression, not only for choirs but also for the assembly, of how the gift of music is so very central to worship and from there one's faith formation and in living the Christian faith, especially as a new choir year begins, especially after its eighteen-month pandemic silence. May it be a reminder and prayer for us all!

When the morning stars together
Their Creator's glory sang,
And the angel host all shouted



Accommodations include newly renovated private room and bathrooms with linens.




