Next weekend is the annual appeal for the Retirement Fund for Religious. As I think you are aware, our religious have, for so many years, served the Church at great sacrifice to themselves and their religious communities to the benefit of the institutions and people they served. Now, the vast majority of religious orders have many more retired and in-firmed in their order than those "out in the field" of ministry. Most of us probably have been beneficiaries

of their services in some way or another. Their service or ministry today is equally significant. They all need our help. In the midst of all the other charities asking, your generosity is very much appreciated by all the retired religious orders of sisters, brothers and priests. (Retired Diocesan priests are not included in this collection.)

- ** Monday is the feast of St. Nicholas. St. Nicholas lived and was a bishop in the late third century is what we know today to be Turkey. He shared his resources through his generosity of anonymous gifts through the land, especially to those in need. This tradition if the foundation of that great guy from the North Pole! St. Nick is the patron saint of children. So on Sunday night remember to put out a shoe, or have your children put out a shoe, and see if St; Nick will leave some treats if they are good or some coal if the need improvement in the "good category."
- ** Monday night, Dec. 6, you are invited to spend some time before our Eucharistic Lord during our monthly Holy Hour, beginning at 7:30 pm. These holy hours are a combination of readings, music, prayer and a good dose of quiet so the Lord can really speak to us. Advent is a prime opportunity to spend some quiet time with the Lord in the midst of all the business!
- ** Wednesday is a Holyday of Obligation, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is the patronal feast day for our country.

The Holydays of the Church are significant solemnities or feasts celebrating certain mysteries of the Lord, our Blessed Mother or the Saints that are to be celebrated by all the people. They still have their purpose of drawing us together into the one Body of Christ. Please take the time to observe the Holydays of Obligation. This Wednesday we have Mass at 7:30 am, 10 am and 7:00 pm.

- ** Thursday night our younger school children will present a little "concert," beginning at 6:30 pm outside in the gym courtyard. All are invited to see, hear, and join in the joyous sounds of the season. Bring a fold chair if you like and some hot cocoa for yourself!
- ** Next Sunday, Dec. 12, at 7:30 pm, the Grosse Pointe Symphony Orchestra will perform their holiday concert in our church, Go to their website for ticket information.
- ** Thank you for your Giving Tree generosity. Many people, young and old, appreciate what you have done to make their life a bit warmer and happier.





O Come, Divine Messiah

Our opening hymn,

"O Come, Divine Messiah, is a French carol which dates from the eighteenth century. It was written by Simon-Joseph Pellegrin, whose career path originally was in a Roman Catholic order, but he later unfolded as a poet and playwright, including texts for operas. He was best known for his great goodness of heart, cheerful nature, and simplicity of manner, as is evidenced in this hymn text. Originally written in French, it was translated in the nineteenth century by Sister Mary of St. Philip, who was one of the first English members of the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur, which was based in Liverpool, England, where this community established a training college in about 1850. The tune is a joyful French carol which dates from the sixteenth century.

who is playing our Masses this weekend. Mr. Miller is in Portland, Oregon, this weekend where he is singing as a soloist with Cappella Romana, an internationally acclaimed and Grammy nominated, professional chamber choir. Mr. Miller is well-known internationally for his basso-profundo voice and is a highly soughtafter specialist in choral music of the Orthodox liturgical tradition, with many recordings to his credit. Music of this tradition calls for deep low basses, singers whose range extends well below the bass staff, and the most rare of all the voice parts. In Portland and Seattle he will be performing the west coast premiere of Benedict Sheehan's Liturgy of St. John Chrysostom under the direction of the composer. Mr. Miller recorded this work with the St. Tikhon's Chamber Choir under Sheehan's direction prior to the pandemic; this recording was named in November as one of the five finalists in the 2022 Grammy awards for best choral recording. This recording is available on YouTube and can be found simply by doing a search for Benedict Sheehan Liturgy. The Liturgy of St. John Chrysostom is the Eucharistic liturgy of the Orthodox Church. Many composers, including Sergei Rachmaninov and Peter Tchaikovsky, have composed settings of the Liturgy though in Church Slavonic; Sheehan's setting is one of the very few settings in English.


