Half and Half As we celebrate the baptism of the Lord, we once again recognize that our faith is rooted in our own "baptism in the Lord." This should be the core from which everything we are, do and say emanates. We have died with Christ in the waters of baptism and have been called to take on his life of service and love in all that we do. Do we??

As I often explain at baptisms, everything goes back to our baptism and our place of baptism. Everything that we are called to be, by God, goes back to our incorporation into the family of God through our baptism, becoming his daughter or son. Everything we do as a Christian flows from our baptism as we are called to be the Light of Christ to others and take on the image of Jesus and His dying and rising in our life. Baptism is a glorious day in the life of the one being baptized!

For the parents of the young one being baptized, it is a foundational day for them as well. They are making life changing promises to God regrading their child. They are asked, "...you are undertaking the responsibility of raising them in the faith, so that, keeping God's commandments, they may love the Lord and their neighbor as Christ has taught us. Do you understand this responsibility?" They are also making a promise to raise the child in the practice of their Catholic faith and religion, being the first teachers of the faith! Of course, being a teacher of the faith is to model the practice of the faith in all aspects of life. With the Grace of God, parents are able to do just that!

Many people also do not realize that, for Catholics, all of our significant religious events are recorded at our place of baptism. Each parish has a big book to record every baptism. Each person has their own line that includes the names of the parents and God parents, date and city of birth and date of baptism, the person baptizing, and then also the dates of First Communion, Confirmation as well as the sacraments of Matrimony and Holy Orders also get noted. Parishes are required to inform the church of baptism for all those sacraments a person receives. This process helps to ensure the accuracy of statements of sacramental reception. It is a standard procedure but when you are asked to request a baptismal certificate, please do so more than a few hours before you need it!

Just a word of clarification about the role of Godparents. Often people think of them as those who will assume the legal responsibility of the child if something happens to the parents. That is NOT the role of Godparents. Godparents, one male and one female by Canon Law, help the parents in providing the formation of the Catholic faith of the person being baptized. That is something that should be taken seriously and not just picking the next person in the family line. Hence, logically, you cannot pick a Jewish friend or a non-Catholic as "Godparents." When it comes to the Sacrament of Baptism, a person must have at least one person who is Catholic that will assume the role of a Godparent. (A person cannot have more than two Godparents. If, for some reason parents insist that there has to be more than two, only two will be recorded in the Baptismal Register.) A Godparent must be at least 16 years of age and fully initiated into the Catholic Church. A person who is a non-Catholic Christian would be recorded as a "Christian witness." (For more information go to our website under the Sacrament of Baptism.)

During the celebration of baptism, the Godparents themselves are asked three times if they are willing and able to assume the responsibilities of raising the child in the Catholic faith. Hence, it is an important lifetime responsibility regarding the faith!

This week let us reflect on the importance of our own baptism and how we are living out our own baptismal promises, or those made when we presented our children to be baptized. Think of the significance of that baptism in your life as a Christian or disciple of

Jesus. How is your life lived out so that others know, without a doubt, that you are a baptized Christian or Catholic?



Songs of Thankfulness and Praise... Baptized with Water...

Our opening hymn, "Songs of Thankfulness and Praise" (Ritual Song, no. 529), recounts the events of Christ's life, from His birth and manifestation to the Magi

(stanza 1), His baptism and first miracle, the changing of water into wine at Cana, and continuing with miracles of healing and His temptation in the desert (stanza 3), concluding with the call, in stanza 4, for us to live mirroring His example. Often times this hymn is sung last Sunday before the season of Lent begins as it recounts the Gospel lessons of the previous weeks in Ordinary Time. The first three stanzas were written by Christopher Wordsworth, a priest during the mid-nineteenth century. A prolific hymn writer, he wrote many of his hymns to teach about the Church's festival, beliefs, and heritage, using language that is simple and direct. The fourth stanza was written by American F. Bland Tucker, who is regarded as one of the most articulate hymn writers of the twentieth century.

Our presentation hymn, "Baptized in Water," (Ritual Song, no. 903) is the second of three hymn texts on baptism the author, Michael Saward, wrote over a four-day period for use as a teaching series on that subject. The text echoes John 3: 5, Ephesians 1: 13, Romans 6: 3-4, and Colossians. 2:12. The tune, *Bunessan*, is a traditional Gaelic melody, and takes its name from that of a small village on the Isle of Mull of the west coast of Scotland. This isle is adjacent to Iona, where St Columba came in the year 563 to establish an abbey, and thereby brought Christianity to Scotland.


