## Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

Next Sunday we begin our celebration of **Catholic Schools Week**. This is a time to draw attention and focus on the many good characteristics and significance of the Catholic Schools in the history of our society and Church. We might naturally think first about elementary schools. Many of us are products of Catholic elementary schools. Obviously, we also think of the many Catholic High Schools in our area or the ones we have attended. However, we cannot forget about the significance our many Catholic Colleges and Universities. All these institutions have made a tremendous impact upon society and the Church through their graduates and their accomplishments. The education, discipline and formation provided in the schools have brought forth many great leaders, thinkers, achievers and individuals.

The parish of Our Lady Star of the Sea is obviously proud of its own elementary school. 

## Stewardship Thoughts

In today's Gospel passage, St. Matthew reflects on Isaiah's prophesy in the First Reading: The people who walk in darkness have seen a great light; upon those who dwelt in the land of gloom a light has shone. This foreshadows what is accomplished in Christ Jesus. In the Old Testament, the "land of gloom" is where Israel's trail to Babylonian captivity began. In this same area, in the fishing village of Capernaum, Jesus begins His public ministry and calls the first Apostles. As Christian stewards, we know that Jesus is our joy and the "Light of the World" Who dispels darkness. We are called to a personal relationship with the Lord and, in turn, are commissioned in a spirit of evangelization to share Jesus' joy and light with all of our brothers and sisters. 
### Saint Francis de Sales: Pastor of Souls




